Biographical/Historical Note (545)

Edward James Hayes served as Senior Vice President and Provost at the University of Houston-Clear Lake (UHCL) from 1994-2007. A native North Carolinian, he received his elementary education in the small town of Boone. The remainder of his education was completed in Detroit, Michigan where he received his Ph.B. and M.A. degrees from the University of Detroit. His Ph.D. from Wayne State University was earned in 1972 with a major in Counselor Education and Cognates in Psychology and Higher Education. He completed his Post-doctorate work at the Institute for Educational Management at

Harvard University located in Boston, Massachusetts. He served as the chief academic officer at Savannah State, Georgia from 1981-1988 before moving back to North Carolina, where he spent the next six years at North Carolina Agricultural & Technical State University.

Dr. Hayes has taught at all academic levels from elementary through advanced graduate level programs. He is a prolific writer, scholar and researcher as evidenced by the twenty articles that were published in top tiered refereed journals. He is also the author of one full-length book, *Busing and Desegregation: The Real Truth*, and continues to present papers at national and international professional conferences. Finally, Dr. Hayes holds memberships in several professional organizations and is an avid fisherman. He retired from UHCL in 2007.

Scope and Content (520)

The majority of the files are records Dr. Hayes brought with him from North Carolina Agricultural & Technical State University to UHCL in 1997. These files include his application for tenure at NCATSU, the university's centennial celebration planning, and general Academic Affairs and Administration files. Correspondence between Hayes and UHCL prior to his hiring is also included as well as his letter of resignation to the chancellor of NCATSU.

Other materials include UHCL publications containing writings by Dr. Hayes, and his personal reference materials concerning, among other topics, abortion rights, discrimination, and affirmative action. The clippings are newspaper articles about Hayes, including his hiring at UHCL and highlights of his accomplishments.
