These documents and photographs were collected from interviewees by the JSC Oral History Project team when conducting oral histories. The collection was brought to the Archives by JSC Historian Dr. Jennifer Ross-Nazzari in March 2007. Photographs were separated from documents at the time of donation and have been kept separated. The number of images in the folder is included in parenthesis on the folder title. Items are arranged alphabetically by the donor's last name. When a document date is not clearly discernable, the year of the interviewee's oral history is given. Established in 1996, the goal of the NASA Johnson Space Center Oral History Project (JSC OHP) is to capture history from the individuals who first provided the country and the world with an avenue to space and the moon. Participants include managers, engineers, technicians, doctors, astronauts, and other employees of NASA and aerospace contractors who served in key roles during the Mercury, Gemini, Apollo, Skylab, and Shuttle programs. These oral histories ensure that the words of these pioneers live on to tell future generations about the excitement and lessons of space exploration. Oral history interviews began in the summer of 1997, and since that time more than 500 individuals have participated in the NASA Oral History projects. In conjunction with the NASA JSC Oral History Project, oral history sessions were conducted for the NASA Headquarters History Office: Administrators; NACA; Herstory; Aviatrix Pioneers; Ballistic Missile Development Pioneers. Also an Oral History Project was conducted to capture the experiences from those individuals involved with the Shuttle-Mir Program (ISS Phase 1). The audio recordings are located at The University of Houston - Clear Lake in the JSC History Collection. Signed releases from the participants are located in the JSC History Collection housed at the University of Houston-Clear Lake.
