# **Biographical/Historical Note (545)**

Oliver W. Markley was Professor and chairman of the graduate program in Studies of the Future at the UHCL, where for many years he taught a course in "Visionary Futures". Formerly he was a consulting futurist and principle investigator with the Management and Social Systems Group of the Stanford Research Institute. Markley was with the faculty at UHCL from the fall of 1978 through the Spring semester, 2000.

The Futures program is part of the School of Human Sciences and Humanities. The program provides a Master of Science after two years of coursework focused on strategic planning and change management.

# Scope and Content (520)

The collection consists primarily of Dr. Markley's writings and subject series. The collection also contains several of his instructor's coursepacks.

### Arrangement

The subgroup documents the creation of the Institute for Futures Studies in 1992. The organizational features for the Institute of Future Studies appear to have been created by Mary Jo Accardo, Director of Future Studies, but they were found among Dr. Markley's files. Original order and folder titles have been kept in most instances.
