Goose Creek Plain

This represents most of the Indian pottery than can be found in the Seabrook area. It has no particular decoration. It is made from local clay and is strictly utilitarian. This type of pottery was fragile and apparently was never intended to be used as a trade item. Many of the vessels were large and had rounded bottoms so they could be placed on soft ground. It would have been easier to re-make this type of pottery than to try to move it to the next camp site.
