CENTER SERIES ADMINISTRATION AND CENTER OPERATIONS

This subseries is composed, for the most part, of correspondence related to the Administration and Center Operations functions at the Johnson Space Center. According to the "JSC Blue Book of Organization", the Administration Directorate is responsible for "providing business management for JSC as an institution and, individually, for the various program / project offices and directorates. The functions are procurement, contracting and contract administration; program control; including integrated planning, scheduling, and contract engineering; management analysis; and the JSC history program." The primary role of the Center Operations Directorate is "ensuring the availability of facilities and services necessary for the operation of the Johnson Space Center." This includes "attending to the total requirements of the JSC physical plant; managing the JSC Construction of Facilities (CoF) Program; providing basic institutional services and, to the extent appropriate, providing program support for each approved activity." (See earlier Blue Books to track changes in the functional statements for these directorates.) The correspondence files in this subseries are arranged chronologically. They are followed by a grouping of GAO audit reports on procurement and CoF practices. In the remaining boxes is a miscellaneous collection of subject files focusing mainly on various facilities on site at JSC. Of particular interest are folders on the Space Environment Simulation Laboratory, the proposed Space Station Neutral Buoyancy Facility and the JSC Child Care Facility.
