

## CENTER SERIES PUBLIC AFFAIRS

This subseries contains an unusual mix of materials that describe the range of functions performed by the JSC Public Affairs Office. PAO is responsible for developing planning programs for the dissemination of public information, handling all news media relations (print, audio and visual), and conducting visitor, protocol, and community relations activities. It also advises the Center Director on the public impact of all NASA/JSC programs. (See JSCI 1132.1H for more detailed information.) This subseries may be considered a case study of the Public Affairs function since it focuses upon the ASTP program of the mid-seventies. During this program, PAO conducted its regular public information activities as well as activities associated with a major international effort. The first two boxes of material contain subject files that give the researcher a clear idea of the variety of concerns that PAO addressed during the ASTP. Also included in the collection is a run of budget related news articles collected by Terry White, a selection of responses to public mail, and miscellaneous transcripts of conferences and briefings. Other products of the Public Affairs Office are stored in their own subseries including the "JSC News Roundup" (the employee newspaper), a run of NASA and JSC News Releases, the JSC Speaker's Bureau publications, and the press kits and air-to-ground transcripts associated with individual missions. The material in this collection is dated from approximately 1971 through 1981. It is filed by subject.
