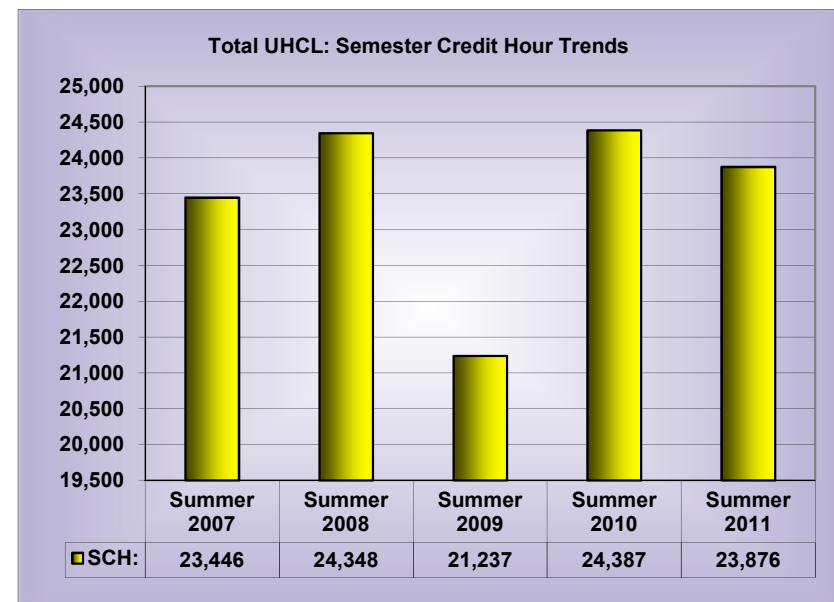

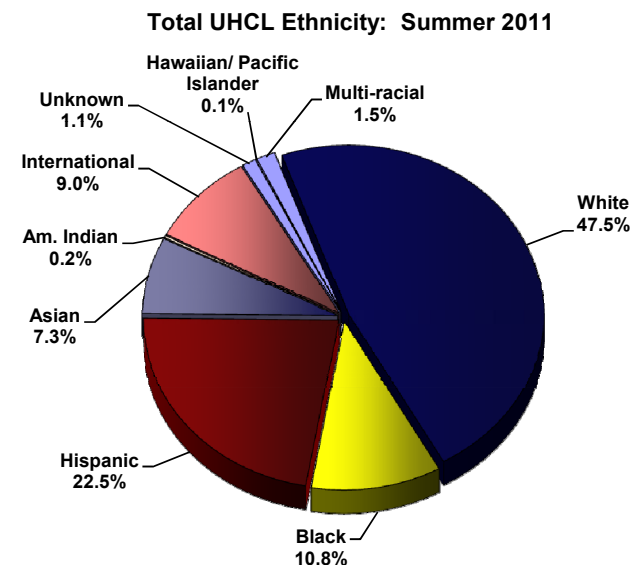

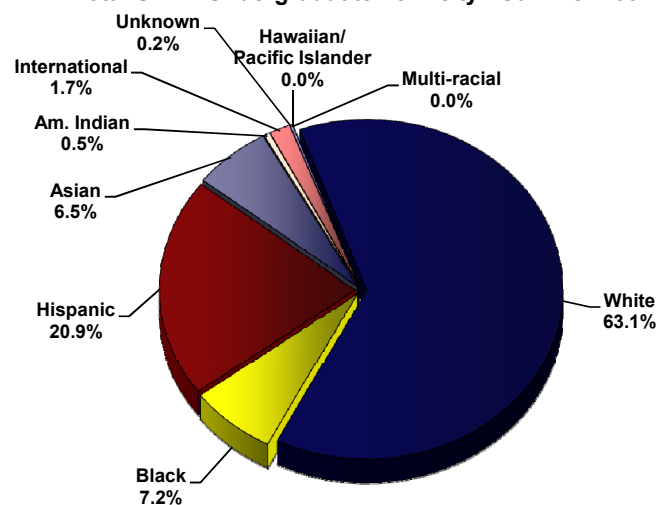

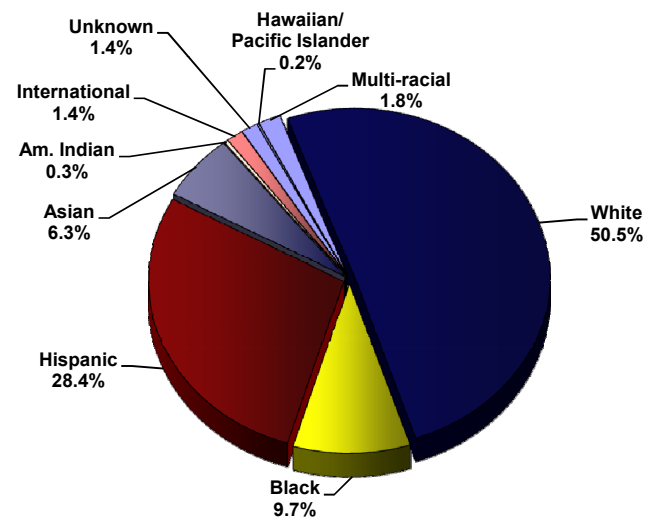

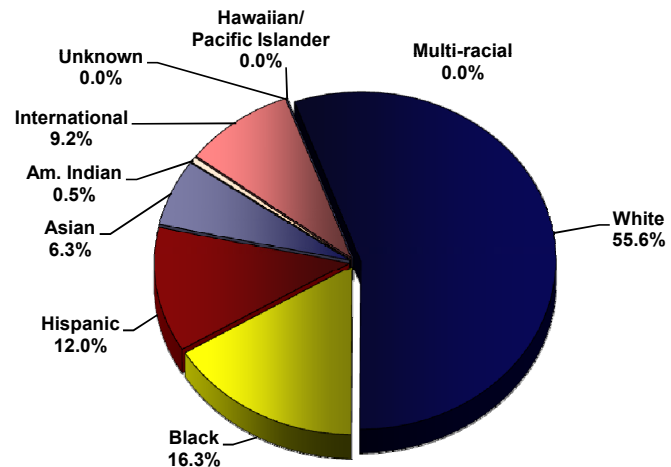

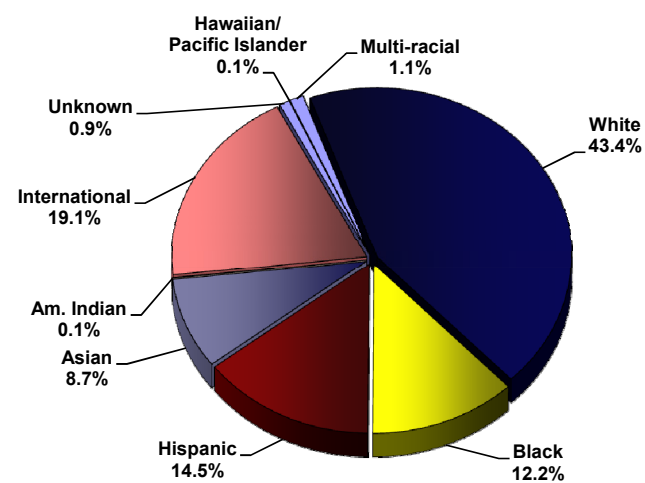

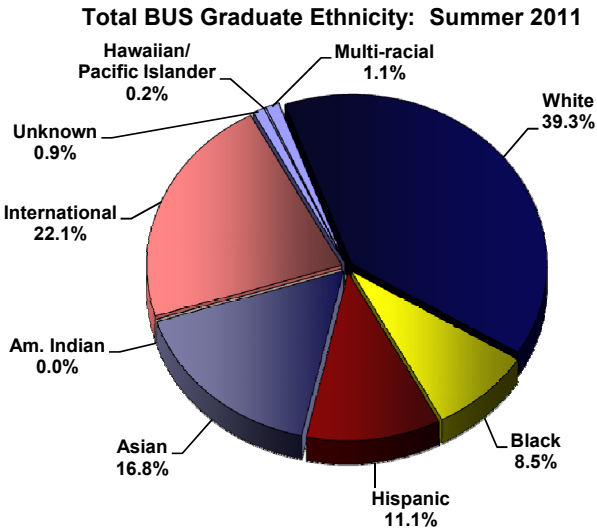

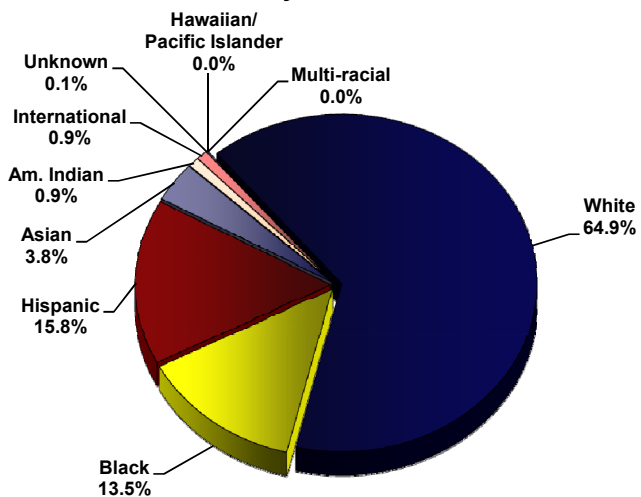

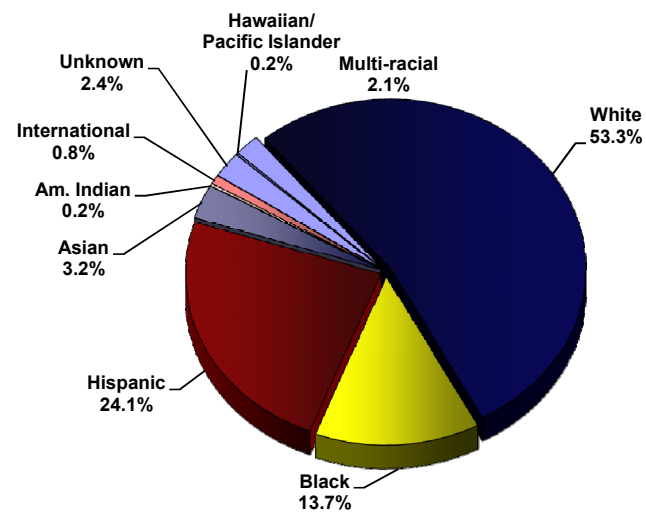

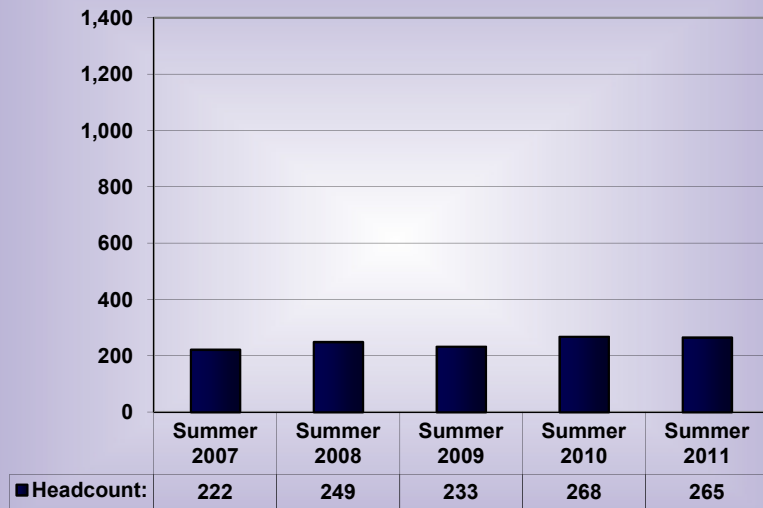

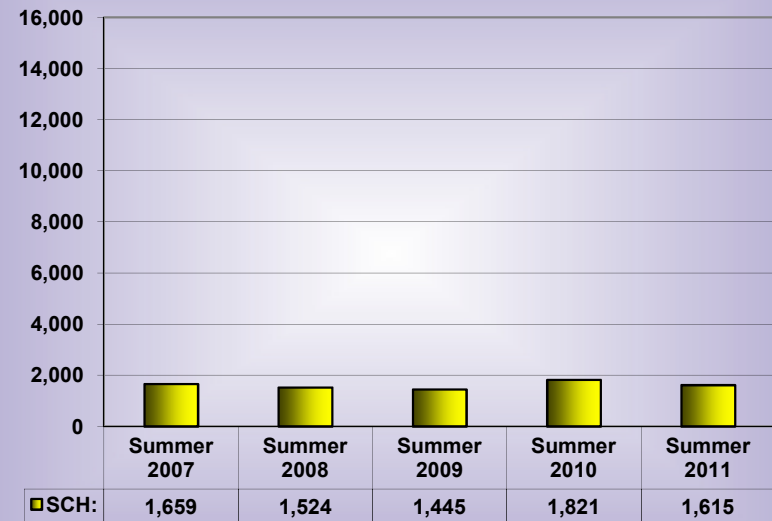

Total SCE Undergraduate: Headcount Trends

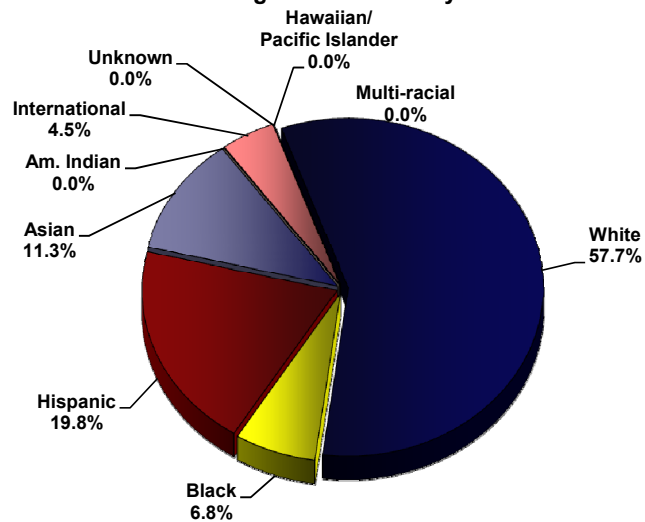


Total SCE Undergraduate: Semester Credit Hour Trends

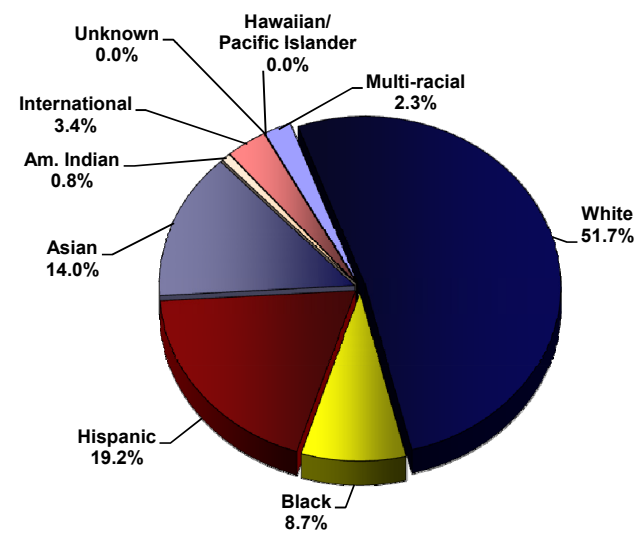

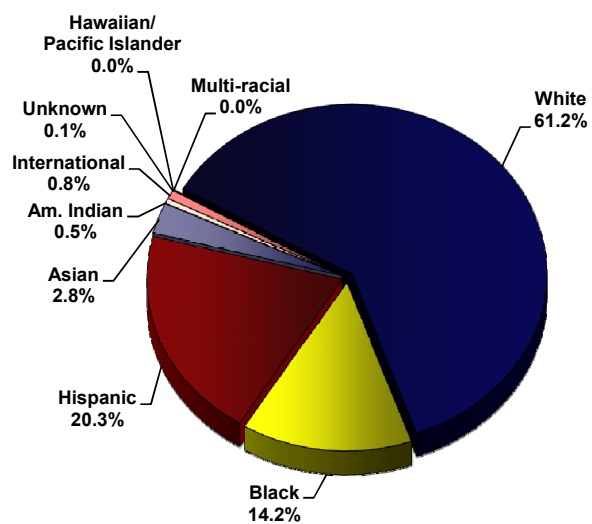

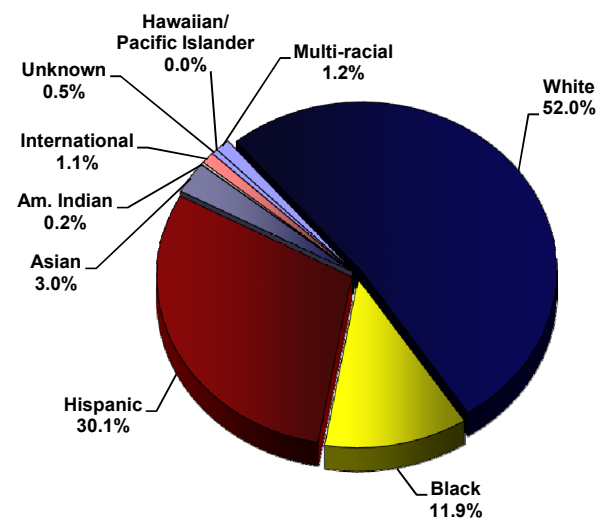

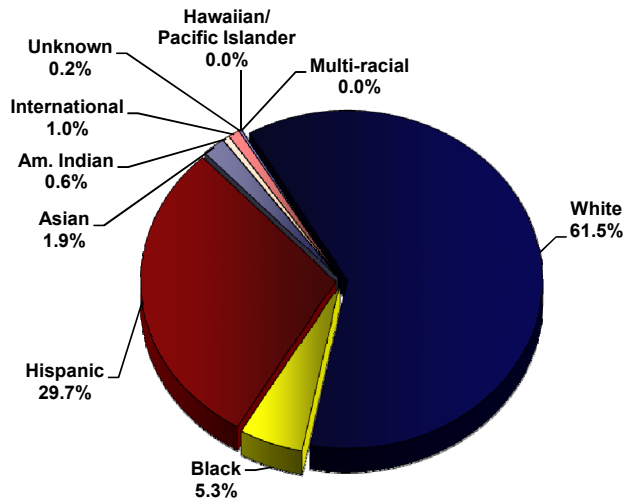

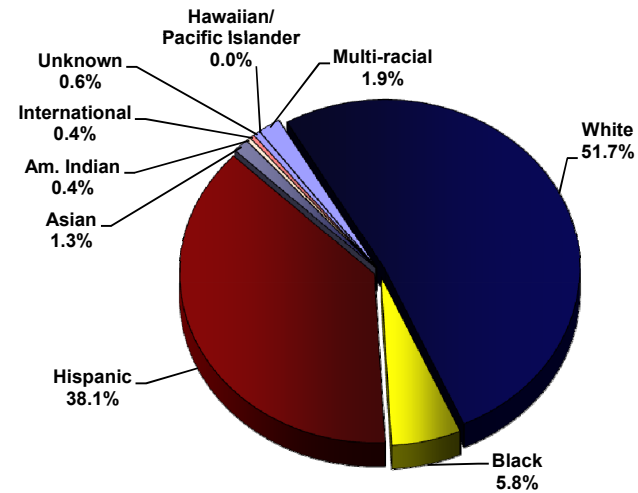

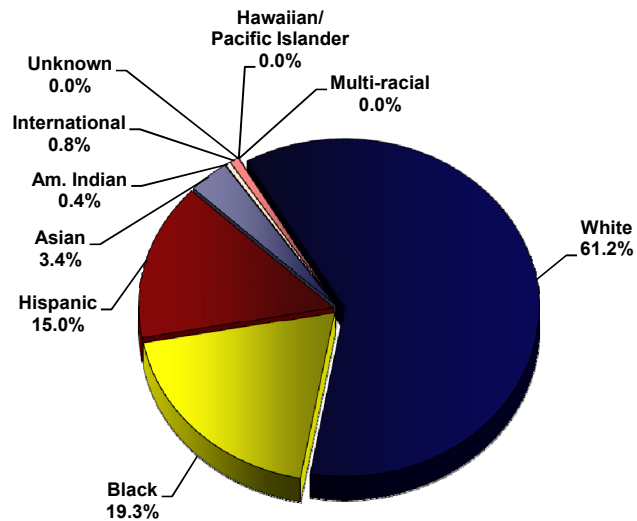

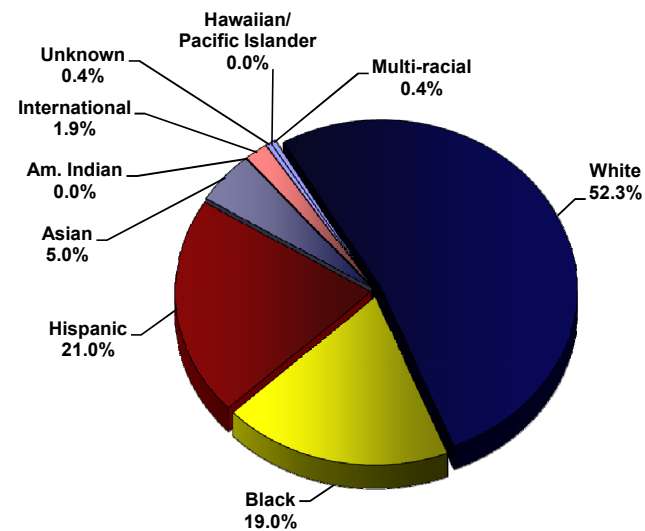

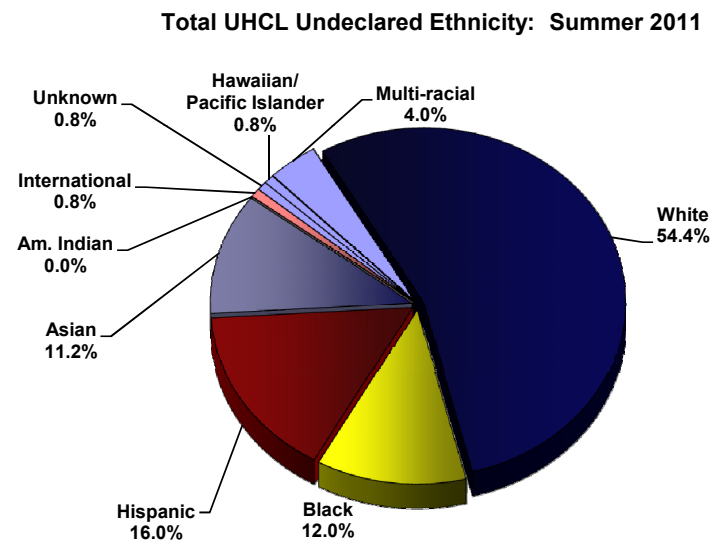
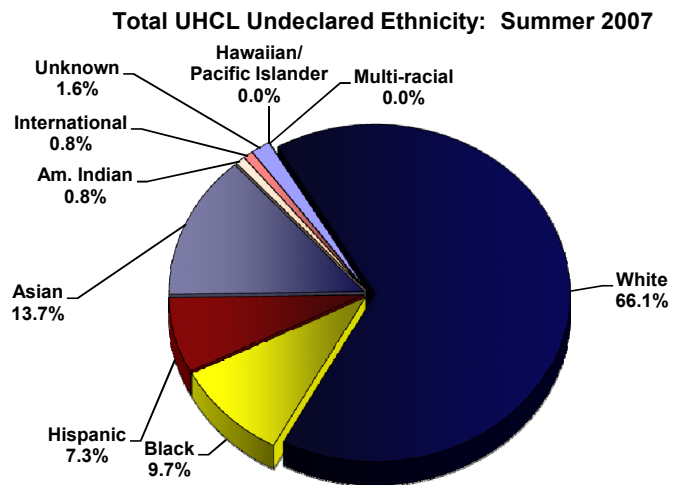
