Historical Note

The Freeman Branch Library first opened on November 1, 1964, in Clear Lake City, Texas. It was named in honor of Captain Theodore C. Freeman, the first NASA astronaut to lose his life in the United States space program. The library moved to the Harris County Multipurpose Annex on July 13, 1976. The current 42,000 square foot joint facility of Harris County and the City of Houston opened on June 8, 2004, and was renamed the Clear Lake City-County Freeman Branch Library.

Scope and Content

The collection is composed of original vertical subject files compiled by reference librarians at the Freeman Branch Library in coastal Houston, Texas, to document the history of the Clear Lake City area from its founding in the early 1960s through 2007. The collection includes copies of deed restrictions for most of the original Clear Lake City neighborhoods; partially documents Houston's annexation of Clear Lake City; Clear Lake City subdivision history and information; Clear Lake area history information; and issues of local publications.
