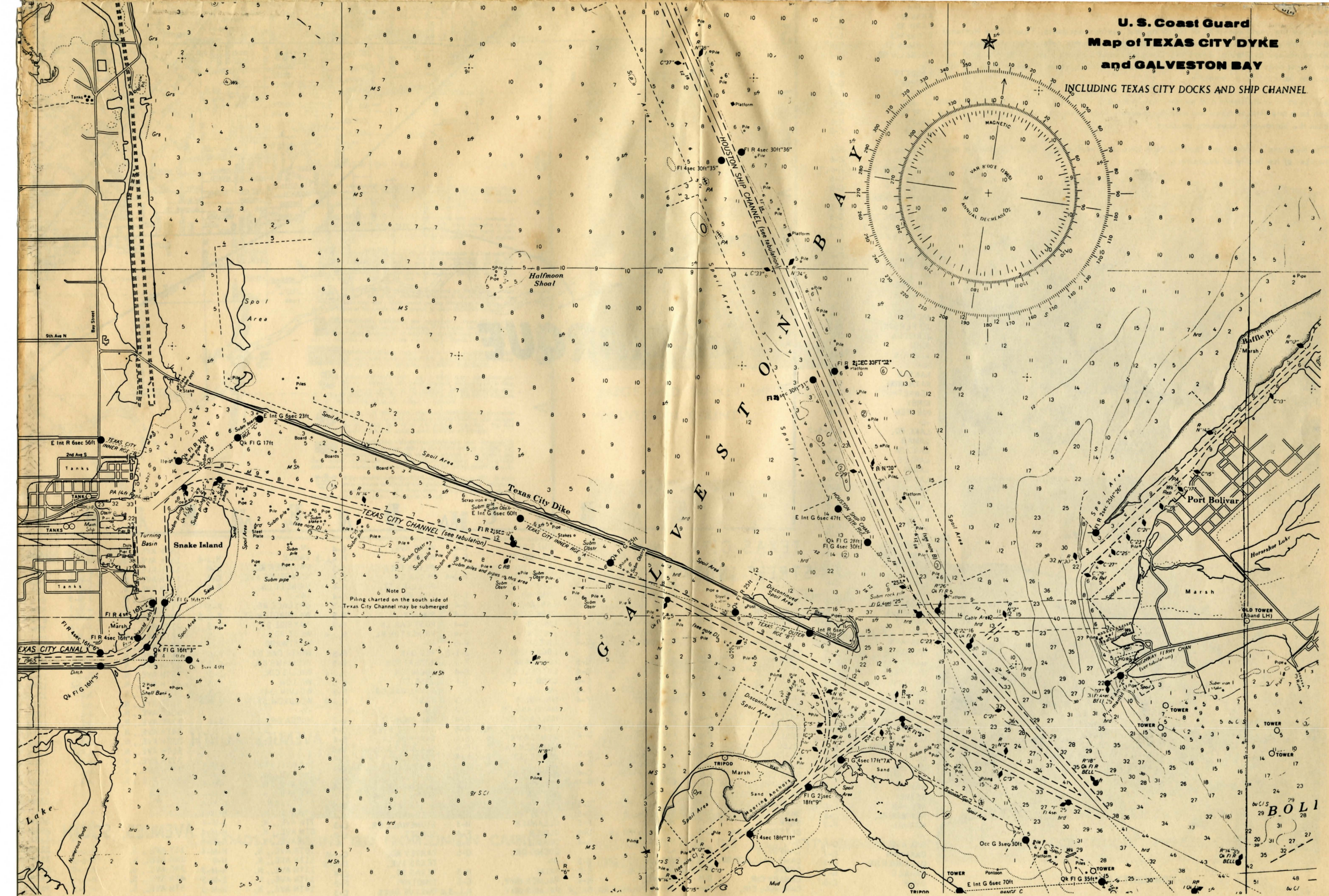
- * Location - On Galveston Bay, 15 miles north of Galveston Island, 35 miles southeast of Houston.

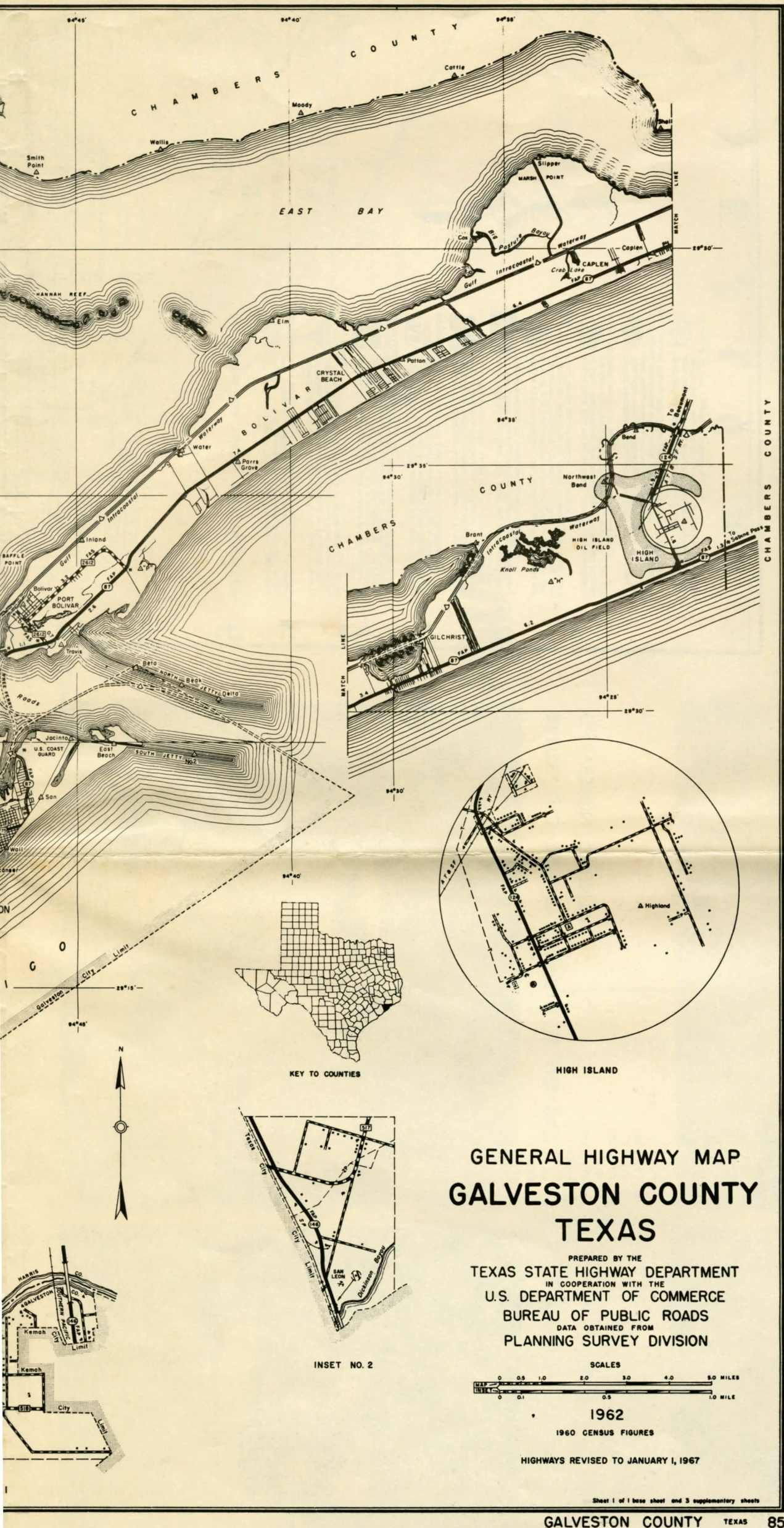

TEXAS CITY DIKE - 5 MILES LONG - PROTECTS SHIPPING LANES



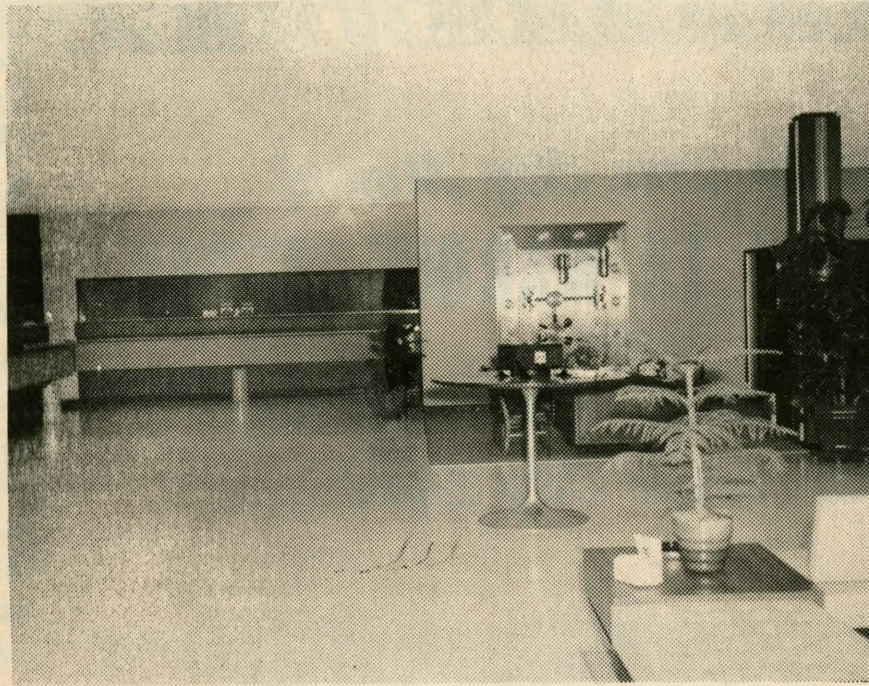

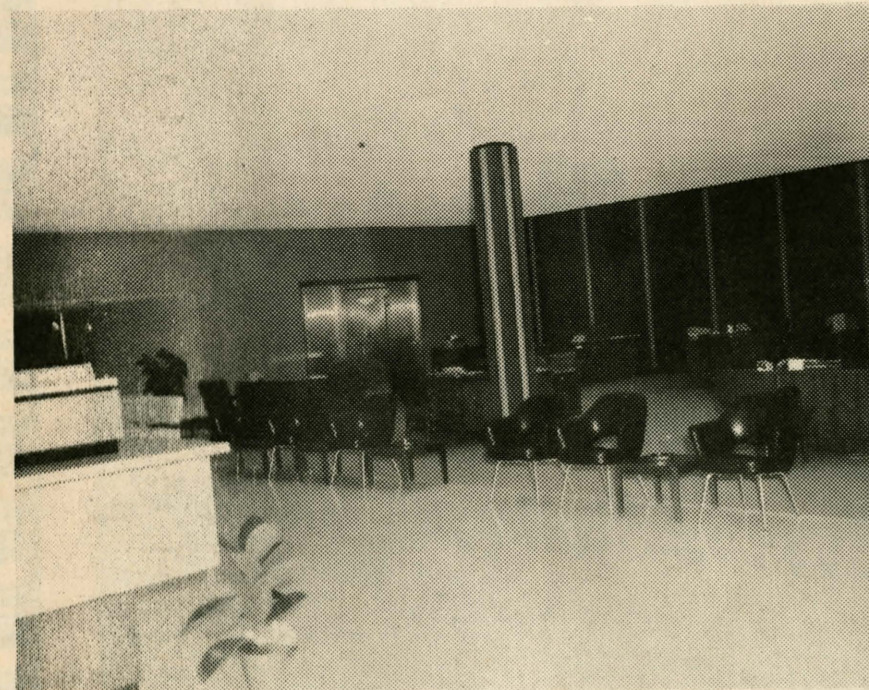

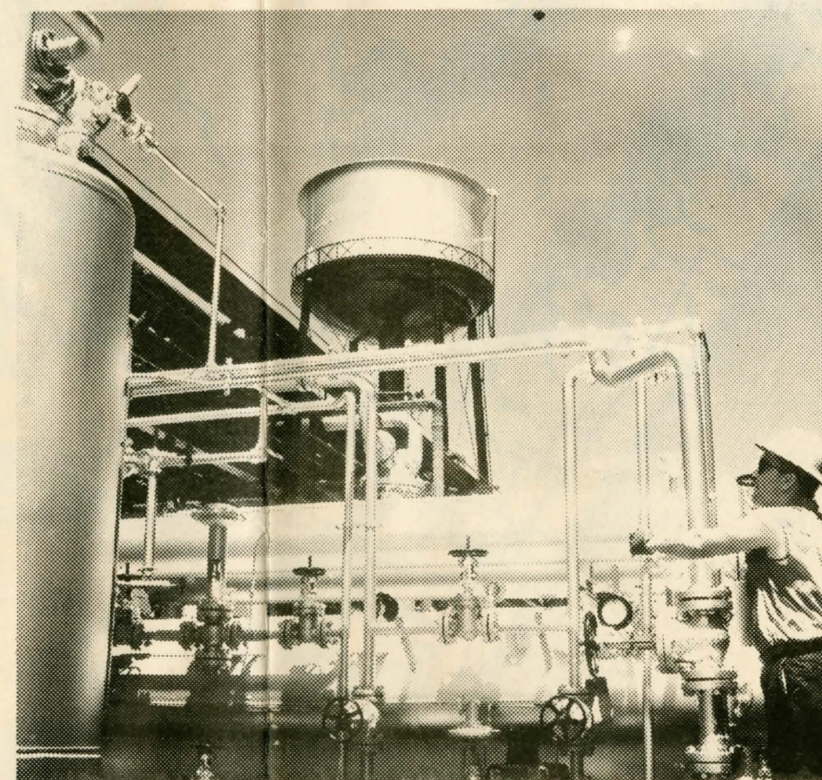

PROCESS UNIT AT UNION CARBIDE



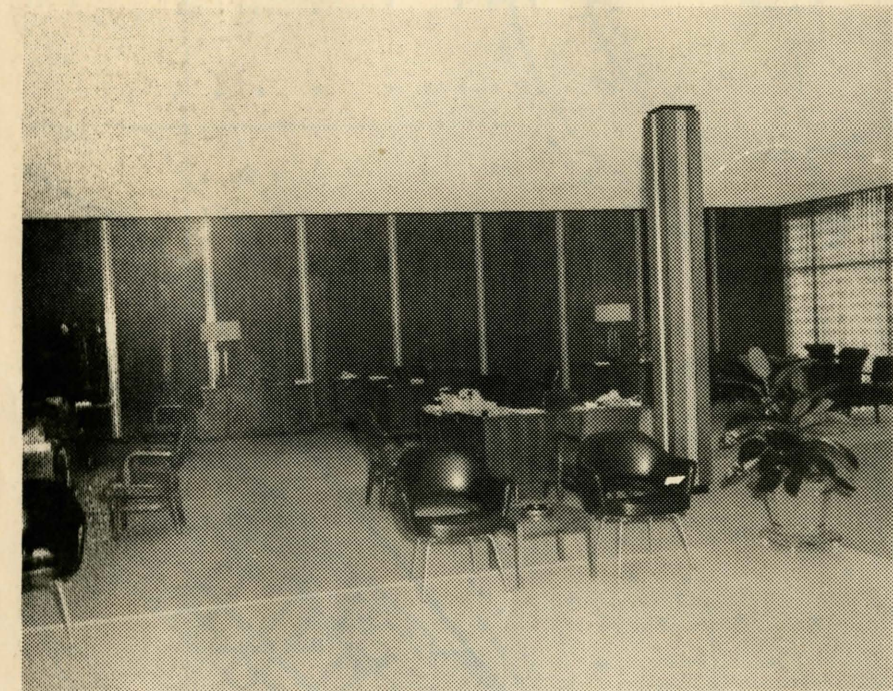

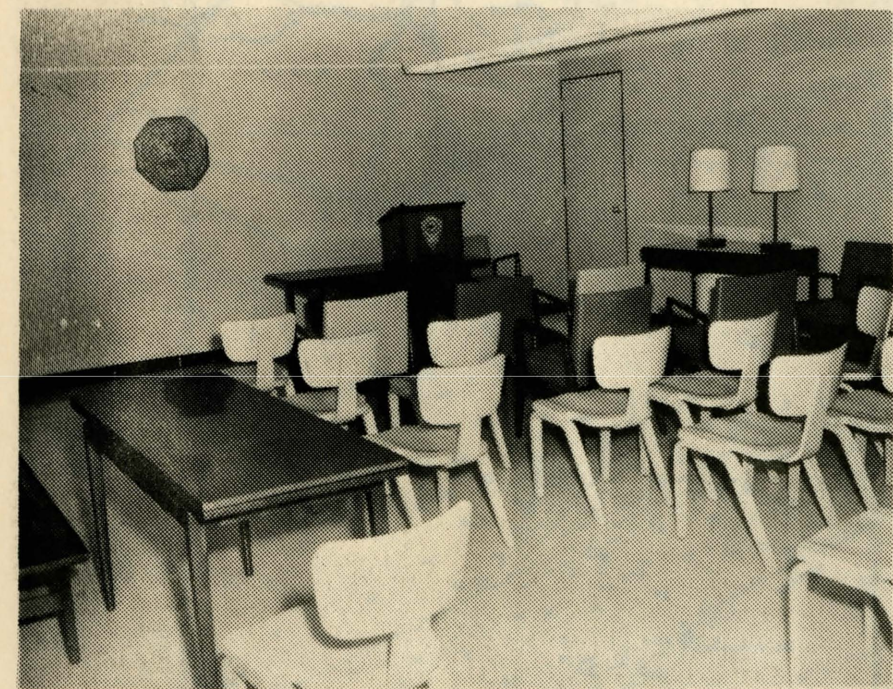
