The Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi is a national, interdisciplinary honor society founded at the University of Maine in 1897. The typical graduating senior chosen for membership in Phi Kappa Phi is selected from the top 5% of the graduating class on the basis of superior scholarship and good character. This collection consists of the correspondence and printed matter related to the founding and early years of the UHCL chapter, which was chartered in 1980 at the request of Dr. Alfred R. Neumann. These papers were originally filed by year within a miscellaneous folder. They have been arranged and processed by Shelly Henley Kelly in June 2004. The collection was donated to the Archives by Dr. Jon Zophy on September 3, 2003.
