Evelyn Meador Library

In February of 1987, ground-breaking was held for the construction of a new library to be located at Elmore and Meyer. The six acres of land had been donated to the city of Seabrook by Rex and Evelyn Meador in 1975. Fundraising for the new facility was secured through the efforts of the Friends of the Library Board.

The 7,200 square-foot facility was dedicated on June 26, 1988. The shelves house over 24,000 books under the care of librarian Cheryl Menard. It is the 23rd branch of the Harris County Library System.
