Biographical/Historical Note (545)

Jan Stockman Simonds served as the Director of the UHCL Dance Program from 1977 to 1992. Born in Janesville, Wisconsin, her family moved to Madison when she was 12. She began attending modern dance classes at the University of Wisconsin that year and attended the University of Wisconsin dance program after graduation from Madison High. She attended the American College Dance Festival in New London, Connecticut and after college graduation moved to New York City, where she lived with Sarah Stackhouse, Joan Taliaferro Hartshorne, and Claudia Gittleman. While taking classes from modern dance greats such as Jose Limon, Pauline Koner, Doris Humphrey, and Merce Cunningham, she taught dance part time at a school in Long Island. She later taught at Branard College. Jan Stockman danced with the Jose Limon Company from 1958-61.

She left New York in 1961 for the University of Illinois where in 1968 she became head of the Dance Department. She received her Masters from the University of Illinois. After marrying Charles Simonds in 1969, they moved to Houston, Texas in 1971, where she continued to take classes and worked as a teacher and dance consultant for the Houston High School for the Performing and Visual Arts. Her two children were born in 1973 and 1976.

In 1975, Jan Simonds choreographed "Moonscrape" for the Houston Ballet. She became head of the UH/CLC dance program in 1977. In 1980, UH/CLC became the first school in the Houston area to offer a B.A. in Theater Arts (Dance). Jan Simonds and her Dance Collective performed throughout the local community and were active in the American College Dance Festival. They hosted the South Central Region in 1988. The UHCL Dance program ended each long semester with their Festival of Dance production.

In 1991, the Theater Arts Program underwent an Academic Review which resulted in the termination of the program. Sadly, the Dance program had no means by which to separate themselves from the Theater Arts program and was also cancelled. At the time Jan Simonds held the rank of full Professor with tenure. While she continued teaching a class, Arts and the Child, and taught a few semesters at UH (central campus), she ultimately became an administrator as Division Chair of Humanities and Fine Arts. She held this position until her retirement in May 2007.

Scope and Content (520)

Files about the dance program, including the Theater Arts Program Review resulting in the cancellation of both Theater and Dance programs are housed first. Simonds kept notebooks resembling scrapbooks of her early years, and these contain flyers, programs, clippings, and other papers documenting dance events during that year. Clippings have been photocopied onto bond paper, photographs have been removed and filed with other photographs at the end. Three student papers were kept by Professor Simonds primarily for the photographs, but they also reflect the choreography techniques taught in her classes. The single project file represents the organization of the American College Dance Festival Association (South Central Region) meeting hosted at UHCL in 1988. Loose items found in the box included programs from outside performances in which Jan Simonds was involved, and publications about the dance program or alumni news.

Photographs are left in this collection, though dance posters are filed with the Broadsides. Many photographs are mounted onto white paper, some were stapled, some mounted with tape. Some have been removed from the original mounting; a photocopy of their original order exists in the folder with the prints. Photographs were donated in one large stack and have been sorted into folders reflecting all photos of one particular dance. Two folders are mixed miscellaneous.

The bulk of the posters are advertising the Festival of Dance, the end of the semester dance production.
