Abstract

The Friends of Evelyn Meador Library History Collection is composed of original and copied historical documents, correspondence, photographs, land records and deeds, school records, board meeting records, calendars, family histories and genealogical information, newspaper clippings and articles, oversized materials, and miscellaneous materials, documenting aspects of the history of the city of Seabrook, Texas, and the wider Clear Lake area. The collection was created by the Friends of Meador Library, the nonprofit support organization for the Evelyn Meador Branch Library of Harris County Public Library, located in Seabrook. The materials cover local organizations and institutions (like churches and schools), non-period copies of land records for Seabrook parcels, and general history of community events and programs.

Historical Note

The Evelyn Meador Branch Library opened on June 26, 1988, as a public library in Seabrook, Texas. The library was started in 1985, when five interested Seabrook residents met with Commissioner Jim Fonteno to inquire about getting a branch library for the Harris County Public Library built in Seabrook. In 1985, the city of Seabrook—with the blessings of Rex and Evelyn Meador—donated to Harris County, Texas, six acres of land originally given to the city by the Meadors. The original library building was heavily damaged when Hurricane Ike hit coastal Houston, Texas, in 2008.

With funding assistance from the city of Seabrook, a new state-of-the-art, environmentally green facility for the Evelyn Meador Branch Library was completed in 2011, being a LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) Gold Certified building. It opened to the public on June 28, 2011—two days after the 23rd anniversary of the original opening of the library in 1988. The Friends of Evelyn Meador Library works with the Harris County Public Library and the city of Seabrook to support making the Meador Library a valuable resource for the coastal community of Seabrook. The nonprofit organization fundraises to help purchase books, audiovisual materials, furnishings, equipment, programming needs and professional development for staff members of the library.

The Friends of Meador Library collected local original and copied historical materials, largely documenting the development of Seabrook, Texas. Many of these archival items come from local families. The materials cover local organizations and institutions (like churches and schools), non-period copies of land records for Seabrook parcels, and general history of community events and programs. The Friends donated this collection to the University of Houston-Clear Lake Archives and Special Collections in 2014, six years after Hurricane Ike hit and three years after the new Meador Library building opened.
