Abstract

The Clear Lake Area Reference Collection contains brochures, pamphlets, newspaper articles, event programs, flyers, publications, and miscellaneous materials, collected by the University of Houston-Clear Lake Archives and Special Collections to document the history of the Clear Lake area of Houston. The materials were originally organized as the "Clear Lake Vertical Subject Files". The materials generally represent published and printed materials accessible to the local public, particularly area residents or visitors, including publications like quarterly newsletters.

Many of the items were published by commercial entities, such as business organizations or chambers of commerce. The collection also includes a significant amount of newspaper or magazine publications, both clipping copies and full documents.

Acquisition

This collection previously constituted vertical files within the UHCL Archives. The materials were not acquired at one single time. Instead, the collection was assembled by the University of Houston-Clear Lake Archives over an extended period. Some of the materials were donated from the Freeman Library in Houston, Texas (in the Clear Lake City region), who had previously kept an archive on local history, while other materials were compiled with those donated. The collection was often a destination for items from other acquisitions that were not connected by topic or purpose to the rest of those collection materials, such as unedited publications stored in a collection of personal papers. These assembled materials were stored as vertical files and were not assigned an acquisition collection number before they were compiled and reprocessed as a collection in 2022.

Separated Material

One item from "Clear Lake Area -- Promotional Brochures" has been moved to oversize storage.

Related Material

Some of the materials in this collection were originally collected by the Freeman Library alongside those that later became the Clear Lake Subject File (CLA-2) collection donated at different times.

Processing Information

The Freeman Library built and kept a large local history vertical subject file collection over a long period. The large bulk of that collection was donated to the Archives and was processed as Clear Lake Subject File (CLA-2) collection. Some of the items not donated as part of the CLA-2 acquisition were later donated as well and became a component of the CLA-1 collection. Some of the vertical subject files in CLA-1 are composed of files or materials donated to the UHCL Archives by the local Freeman Library, which may have originally been in this collection but got separated with time.

In the spring of 2022, the UHCL Archives began utilizing a new collection numbering system to better represent its collecting areas by using abbreviations for the collecting areas. Previously the Archives used its accession numbers as the collection number, such as "2011-0001," where the year indicates the year it was official accessioned and the number "1" is the order in which it was

accessioned that year. For Clear Lake Area Collections, the new numbering abbreviation for Clear Lake Area Collections is "CLA." The Clear Lake Area Reference Collection was assigned the first number in this new numbering system, as "CLA-1."

The original collection, stored in vertical files by the UHCL Archives once received into its holdings until early 2022, was originally organized alphabetically by the name of the item, topic, event, or institution. An inventory of all the folders was produced and updated until 2021. During reprocessing of the materials to convert them into a reference collection t, materials were reordered to improve relevance. Some coverings and bindings on the archival items were removed, due to their acidic nature or bulkiness, to improve long-term preservation in storage.

Non-unique duplicates for some items within the collection were removed in keeping with UHCL Archives processing procedures. Some of these items were determined to be duplicates of materials located in other collections in the Archives, and extra copies were determined to not be needed for retention. The items were removed from the collection.

Arrangement

Items are organized into two sections. Those pertaining to a particular area or region are organized at the front, alphabetized by region; those not attached to a region are grouped at the back. Within these sections, items are stored alphabetically by name.

Scope and Content

This collection contains brochures, pamphlets, educational handouts, programs, flyers, guides, articles, and miscellaneous materials, collected by the University of Houston-Clear Lake Archives and Special Collections to document the Clear Lake region of Houston. The materials were originally organized as the "Clear Lake Vertical Subject Files" and include materials originally acquired by the Freeman Library and later donated to the UHCL Archives.

The materials generally represent published and printed materials accessible to the local public, particularly area residents or visitors, including publications like quarterly newsletters. Many of the pieces of ephemera were produced by local professional organizations such as chambers of commerce. The vast majority of the materials are printed paper items, including booklets, brochures, and newspaper copies. There is one compact disk within the collection, identified in the folder title where it is stored.
