If variance exists when comparing these figures to other previously published reports, it is important to note that these data may follow a different methodology. 




First Time or Transfer students are recorded on the certified CBM-001 report and represent students entering the reporting institution for the first time but who have previously attended another postsecondary institution at the same level (e.g., undergraduate to undergraduate or graduate to graduate). This does not include an institution's own graduates who re-enter for further education. This variable does include graduate students who are accepted into a master's or doctoral program for the first time. A "No" for this variable would indicate a continuing or returning student.

Residency represents the county, state, or foreign country of which the student is a resident as identified by the student as his/her permanent address at the time of application to the institution. This variable should not be used to identify how students are actually charged tuition as other factors are involved in that determination.

⁴ Tuition status indicates the status of the student for tuition purposes. Beginning Fall 2006 new measures were implemented to provide a greater level of accuracy for this variable. However, this variable is not a reliable indicator for how tuition may have actually been charged to students.







Total UHCL Ethnicity: Fall 2013




Figure 2: Total UHCL Undergraduate







Total UHCL Undergraduate Ethnicity: Fall 2013




Figure 3: Total UHCL Graduate







Total UHCL Graduate Ethnicity: Fall 2013




Figure 4: Total School of Business (BUS)







Total BUS Ethnicity: Fall 2013




Figure 5: Total School of Business (BUS) Undergraduate







Total BUS Undergraduate Ethnicity: Fall 2013




Figure 6: Total School of Business (BUS) Graduate







Total BUS Graduate Ethnicity: Fall 2013




Figure 7: Total School of Human Sciences and Humanities (HSH)







Total HSH Ethnicity: Fall 2013




Figure 8: Total School of Human Sciences and Humanities (HSH) Undergraduate







Total HSH Undergraduate Ethnicity: Fall 2013




Figure 9: Total School of Human Sciences and Humanities (HSH) Graduate







Total HSH Graduate Ethnicity: Fall 2013




Figure 10: Total School of Science and Computer Engineering (SCE)







Total SCE Ethnicity: Fall 2013




Figure 11: Total School of Science and Computer Engineering (SCE) Undergraduate







Total SCE Undergraduate Ethnicity: Fall 2013




Figure 12: Total School of Science and Computer Engineering (SCE) Graduate







Total SCE Graduate Ethnicity: Fall 2009






Figure 13: Total School of Education (SOE)




Figure 14: Total School of Education (SOE) Undergraduate







Total SOE Undergraduate Ethnicity: Fall 2013




Figure 15: Total School of Education (SOE) Graduate (includes Doctoral)










Total SOE Graduate Ethnicity: Fall 2009





Total UHCL Undeclared Ethnicity: Fall 2013




	Figure 17: Data Definitions Query GY_UHCB_001_0

- c) Continue to report students who have applied to or have a petition pending with the Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration Services and students who base their residency on visas that allow them to domicile in the U.S. as international students.
- d) Unknown or Not Reported: The unknown classification should only be used if the student has not selected a racial/ethnic designation and the institution finds it impossible to place the student in one of the categories during enrollment, post-matriculation, or verification processes.

First Time or

Transfer

First Time or Transfer students are recorded on the certified CBM-001 report and represent students entering the reporting institution for the first time but who have previously attended another postsecondary institution at the same level (e.g., undergraduate to undergraduate or graduate to graduate). This does not include an institution's own graduates who re-enter for further education. This variable does include graduate students who are accepted into a master's or doctoral program for the first time.

A "No" for this variable would indicate a continuing or returning student.

Examples:

A student from UHCL graduates as an undergrad and enters a graduate program at UHCL for the first time, then the student would be coded 000001 (entering a graduate program for the first time). The student is not a transfer. If a graduate student transfers from WTSU and enrolls into a graduate program at UHCL and is entering UHCL for the first time, then the student would be coded with WTSU's FICE code as a transfer student.

Residency

Residency represents the county, state, or foreign country of which the student is a resident as identified by the student as his/her permanent address at the time of application to the institution. This variable should not be used to identify how students are actually charged tuition as other factors are involved in that determination.
