**HOUSTON!!**

HOUSTON, TEXAS, was selected as the permanent site for Manned Spacecraft Center in September 1961. A small cadre of Center Operations, Procurement, and Personnel employees opened temporary offices in the Gulfgate Shopping City early in October. The move of 751 NASA employees and their families from Langley Air Force Base to Houston was completed July 1.

The permanent site at Clear Lake is now under construction and is scheduled for completion about the end of 1963. During the interim period, Manned Spacecraft Center's operations in this area are being housed in 11 different sites in Houston and additional space at Ellington Air Force Base.






