

FESTIVAL OF THE TEN DAYS TO RENDEZVOUS

June 10 through June 19

The Festival will be kick-off Friday with the Fishing and Crabbing Contest that will last all 10 days - headquarters to be in Seabrook. Also a ten day Art Show at the Art Barn in Kemah begins Friday. Nassau Bah will have a large Antique Show for Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Sail and power boats will cruise all week gaily lighted in all colors.

In the early evening there will be a Cocktail Party at the Crest Hotel where guests will see an Aquacade. The President of the Festival, the Queen, Duchesses and Princesses will be introduced. Guests may then go to the music program at the high school, presented by the Bay Area Chorus, or over to Kemah to enjoy the Carnival

Saturday - There will be a Trap and Skeet Shoot all day in Kemah, and in the afternoon, a Baby Bathing Beauty Contest for toddlers up to three years, for both boys and girls. A Prince and Princess will be chosen. In the evening, one of the exciting events is a Lighted Barge Dance, with a Hawaiian theme; the barge to be anchored off the fabulous new Watergate Marina. This event will be fun and most unusual, as guests can come by land or by sea and beachcomber-type clothes will be worn. The fine Jerry Miller Band will play.

Sunday will feature the first Canoe Race since the Indians lived by the lake. Afterwards, a Tug-O-War across the Creek between Kemah and Seabrook is planned. In the afternoon, the fine Water-Ski exhibition will go on over at the Clear Lake at Nassau Bay.

Monday's events will feature the Ballet Evening. The Allegro Ballet of Houston will come to Clear Creek High and musical entertainment plus an Art Show are planned.

There will be three nice luncheons for the ladies during the week at Kemah, Clear Lake City and Webster.

The teen-agers are included in the Festival, with two special events - a Teen Dance at the Tiki and a Treasure Hunt around the six cities.

Wednesday evening will feature a Bridge Tournament at the Webster Recreational Center.

Thursday is a big day - the Rendezvous Dog Show at the Galveston County Park in League City will include a "Mutt" Show. It is also the opening night of "The Boy Friend" at the Clear Creek Country Theatre.

Friday will see the start of a Country Fair and Horse Show at the Harris County Boys School and the Junior Olympics at Webster. There are already 320 swimming contestants "signed-up".

Saturday will be the big day at the Festival with the Parade and Motorcade planned to end at the Galveston County Park, where a Barbeque, Square Dancing, Indian Exhibition dancing, Ski Exhibition, and Barber Shop Quartet and western singing will be in order. In the evening, guests are invited to the Country Theatre in the western clothes.

Sunday's events will start with a Non-denominational Service at the Wild-Cat Stadium at 7:30 A.M. There will be another Water Ski Show, the final day of the Horse Show, and then the big Rendezvous Derby Race will go on in the Lake, with stars of the racing world. Land around the lake offers many spots for good viewing.

People will have a chance to see our many subdivisions and a choice of all the activities for a vacation right at home.
