The clubhouse of the Seabrook Hunting and Fishing Club was situated on the water's edge near the entrance to the Clear Creek Channel. Often referred to as the Seabrook Clubhouse or simply the Clubhouse, the dining facilities, entertainment and hotel accommodations, made it an ideal site for regatta spectators and headquarters beginning with the 1907 event.
