**Biographical/Historical Note (545)**

Henry "Hank Eggers" (1938-2012) was born in Philadelphia PA and was an Electronics Technician in the U.S. Navy. Shortly after leaving the U.S. Navy in the early 1960s, Eggers became a Field Engineer for General Dynamics Corporation. He was sent to Houston from San Diego California to work at NASA under contract on installing and maintaining the IBM 4020-Bitserver as well as other computer and electronics equipment. He was responsible for the design of several circuits to improve the speed and efficiency of the system and conducted meetings with representatives from Kodak and Lockheed and showed demonstrations of the "4020" as they were interested in purchasing this type of equipment.

**Scope and Contents (520)**

The items in this collection consist of Manned Spacecraft Center/Johnson Space Center memorabilia from Eggers' personal collection from his time working as a contractor for General Dynamics Corp. in the early 1960s.
