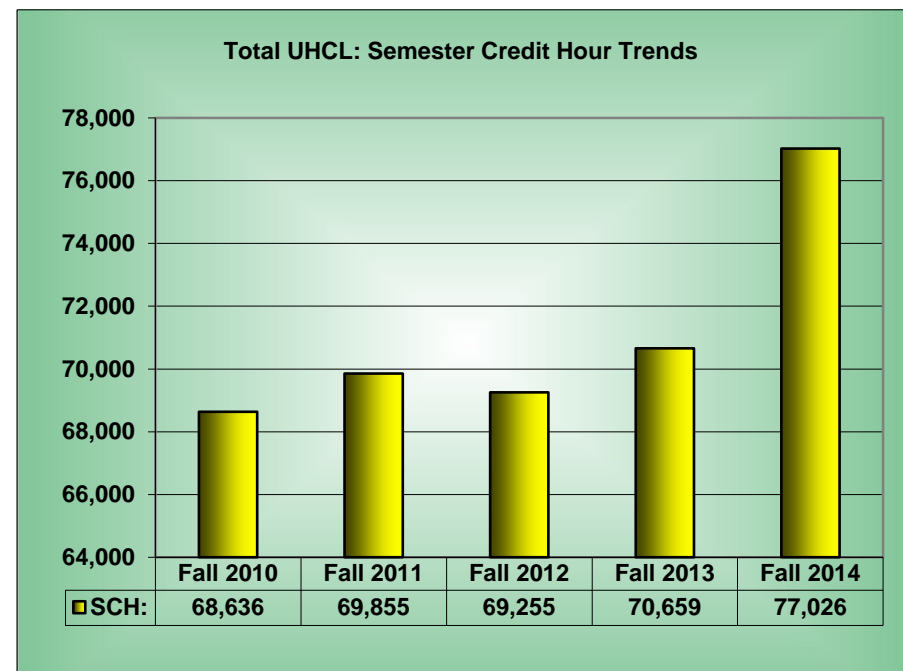

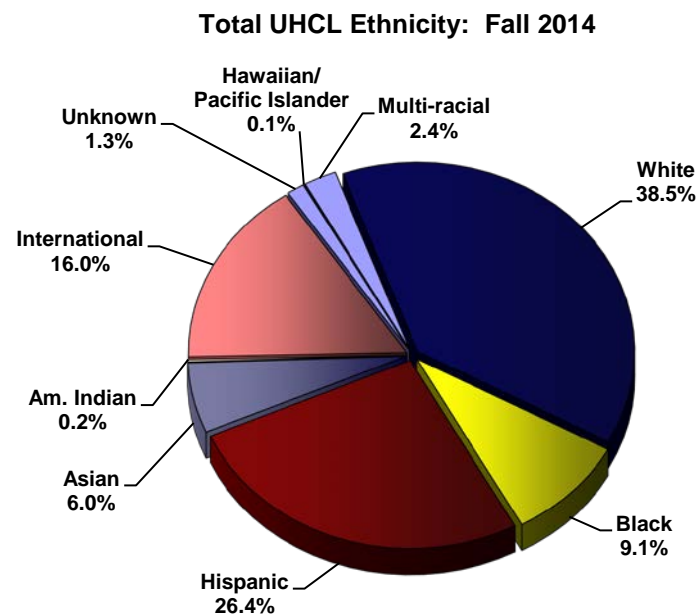
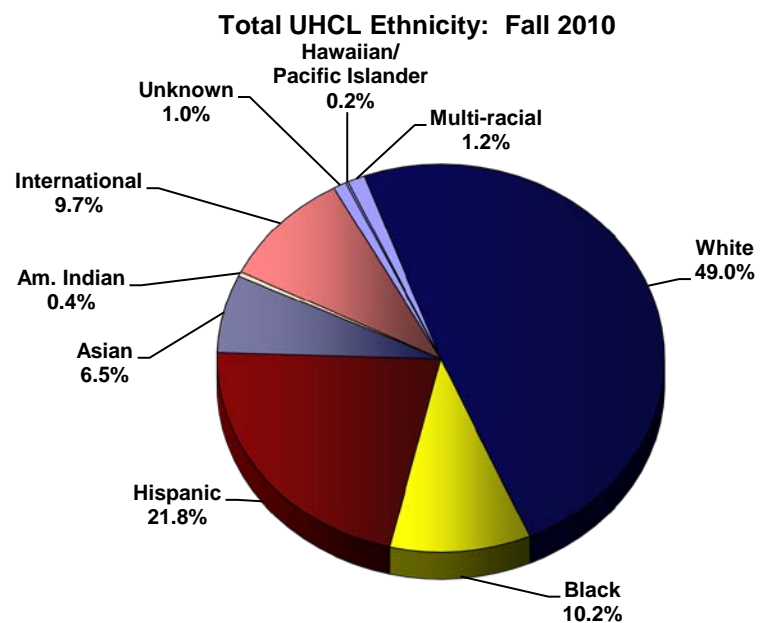

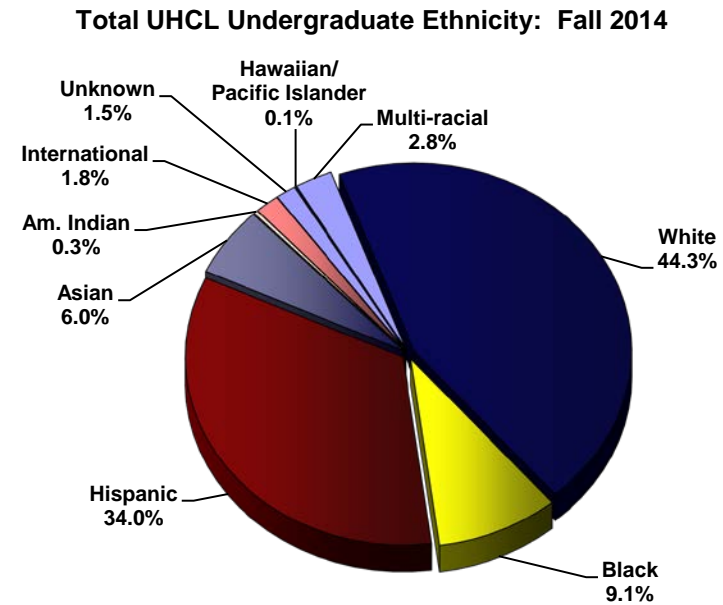

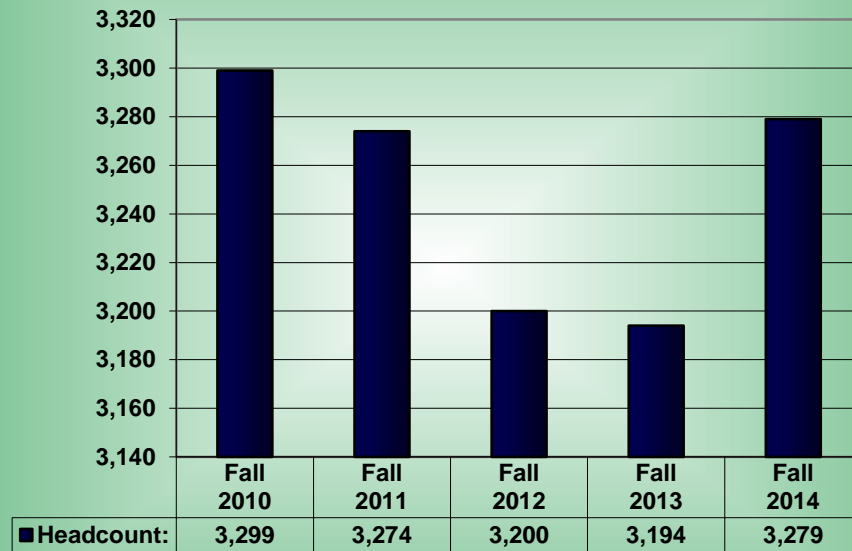

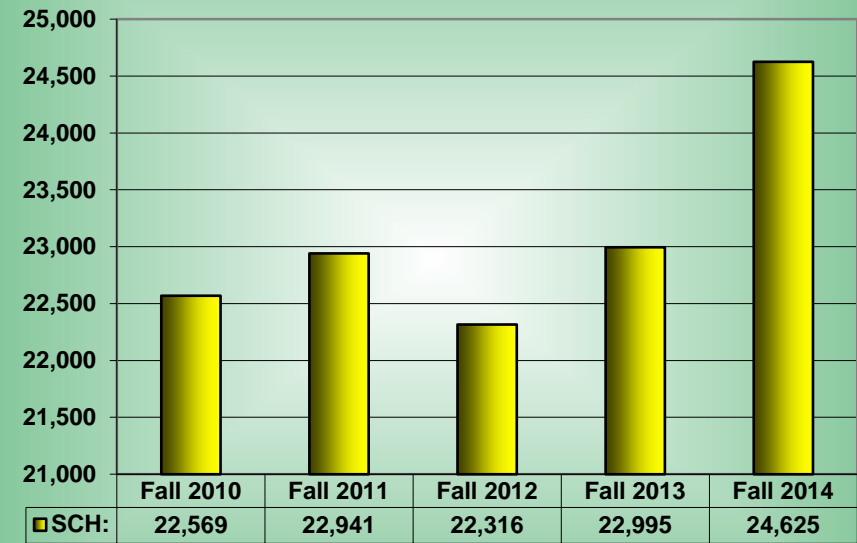

Total UHCL Graduate: Headcount Trends

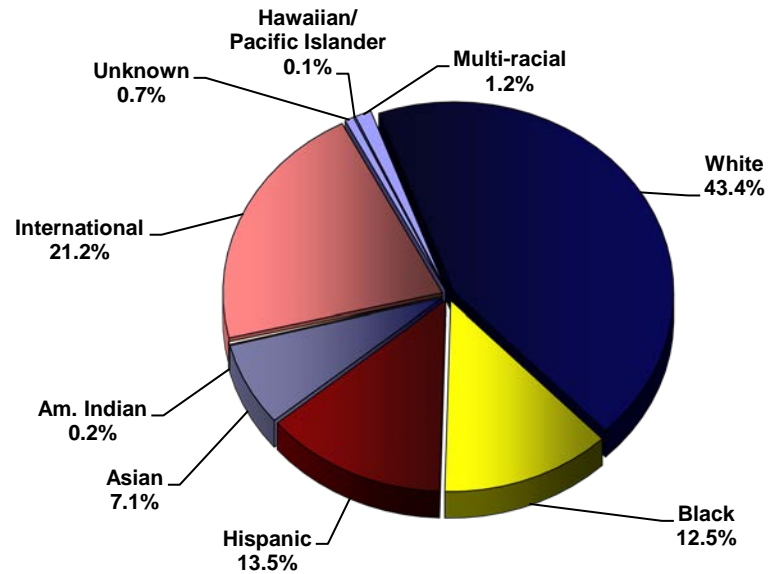


Total UHCL Graduate: Semester Credit Hour Trends

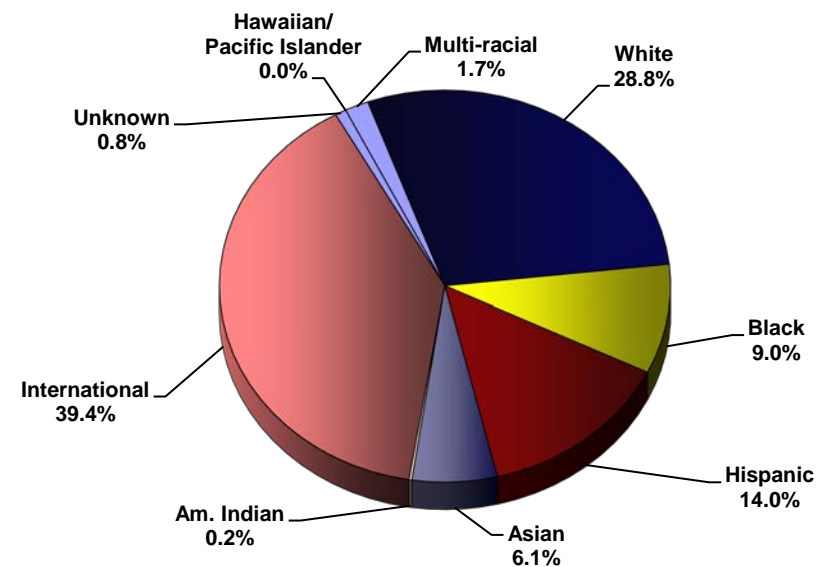

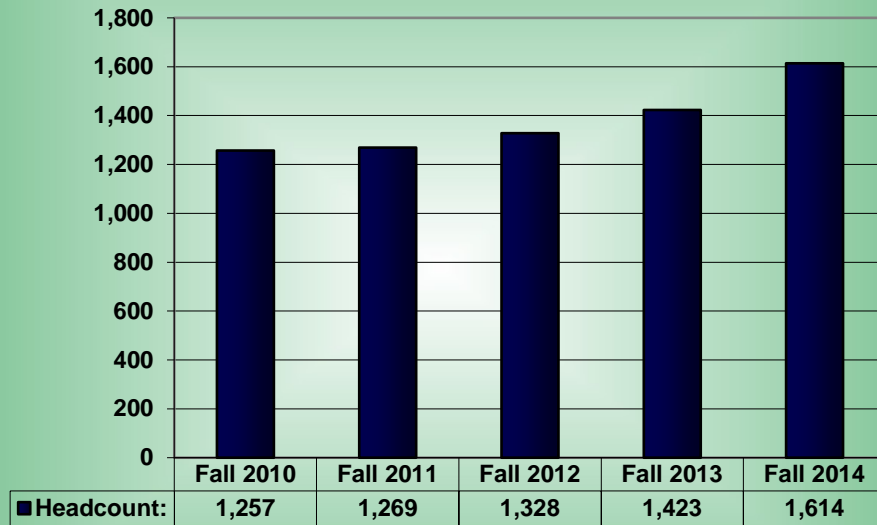

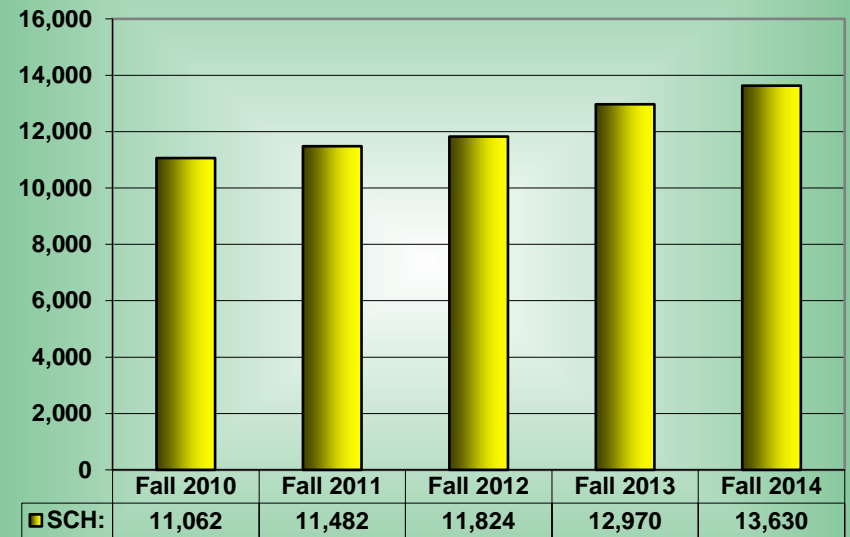

Total BUS Undergraduate: Headcount Trends

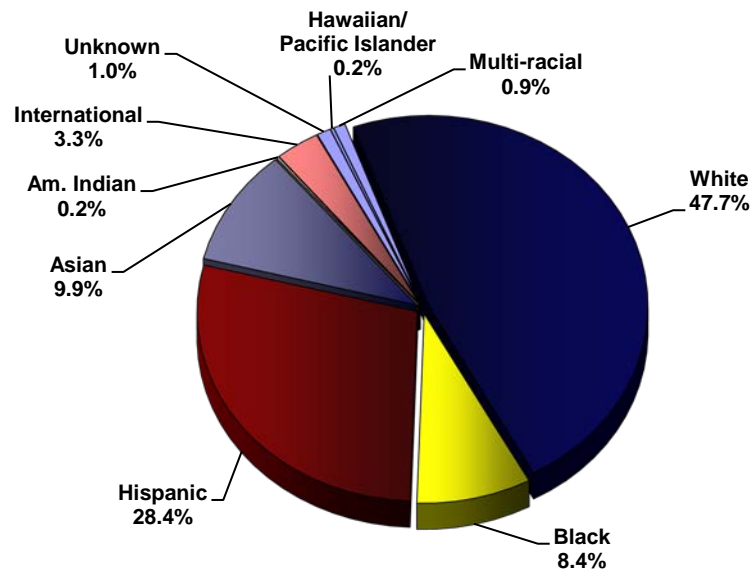


Total BUS Undergraduate: Semester Credit Hour Trends

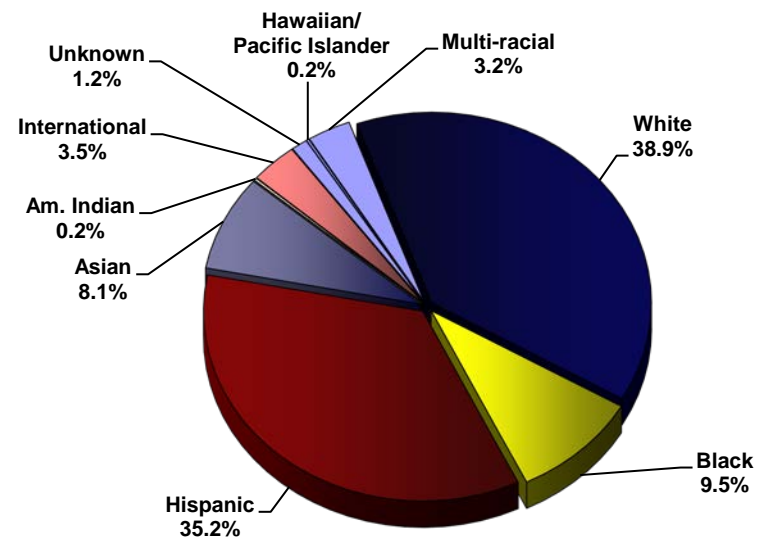

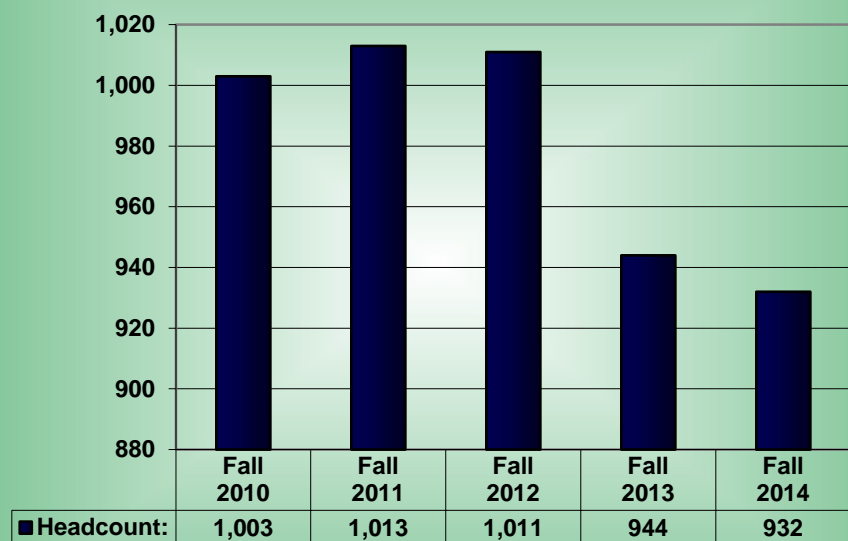

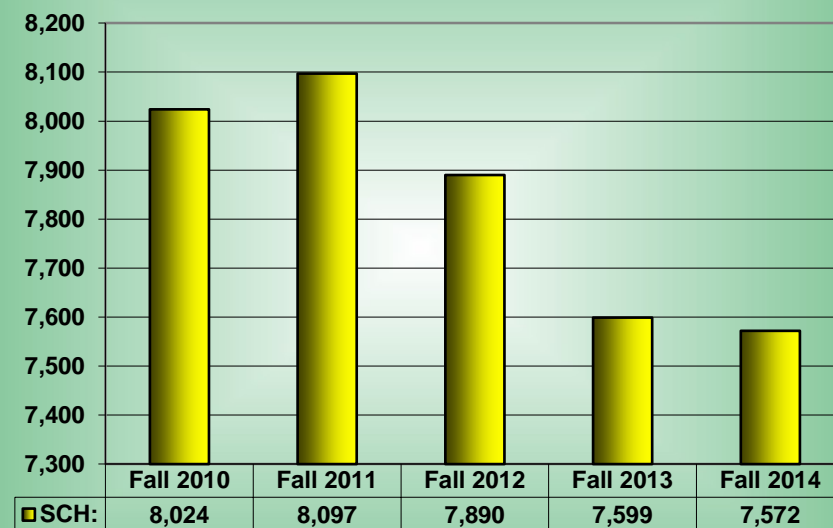

Total BUS Graduate: Headcount Trends

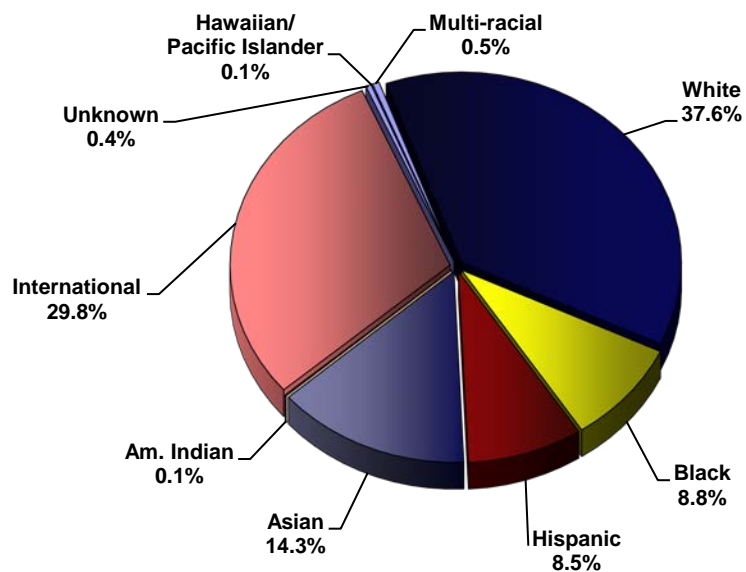


Total BUS Graduate: Semester Credit Hour Trends

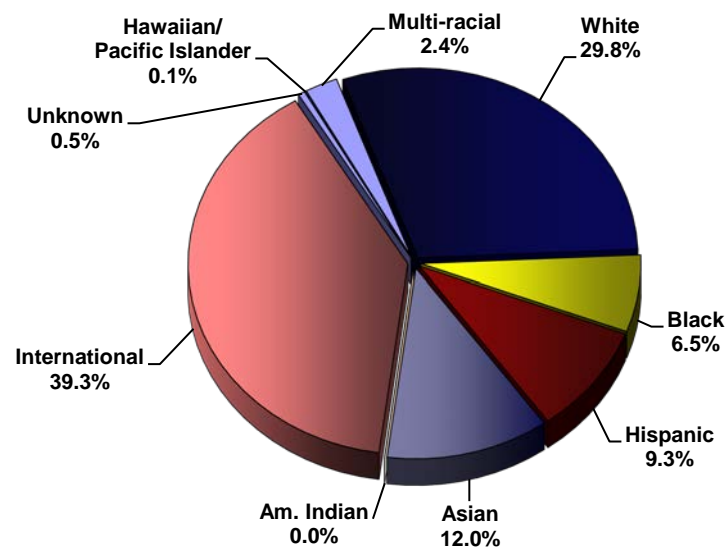

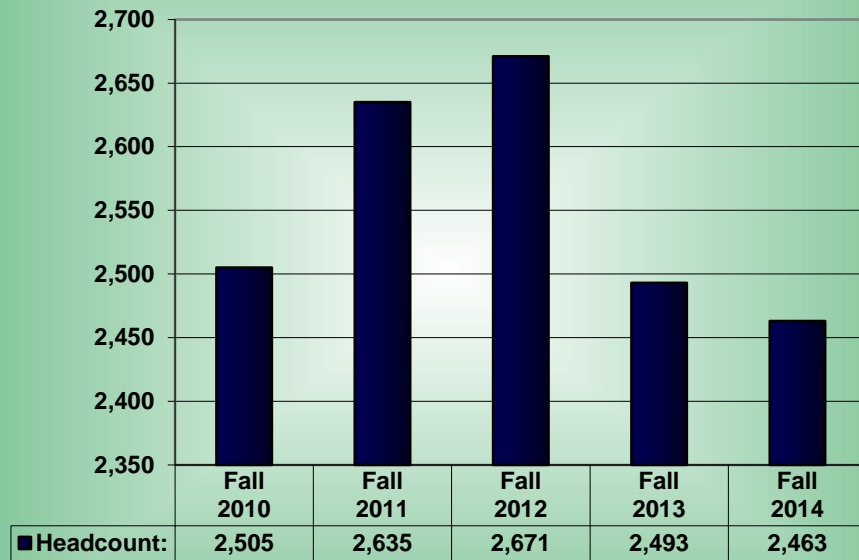

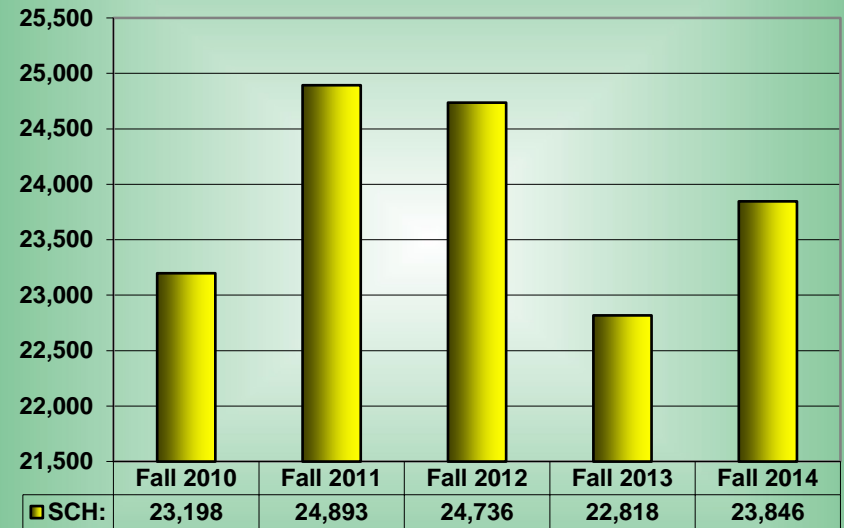

Total HSH: Headcount Trends

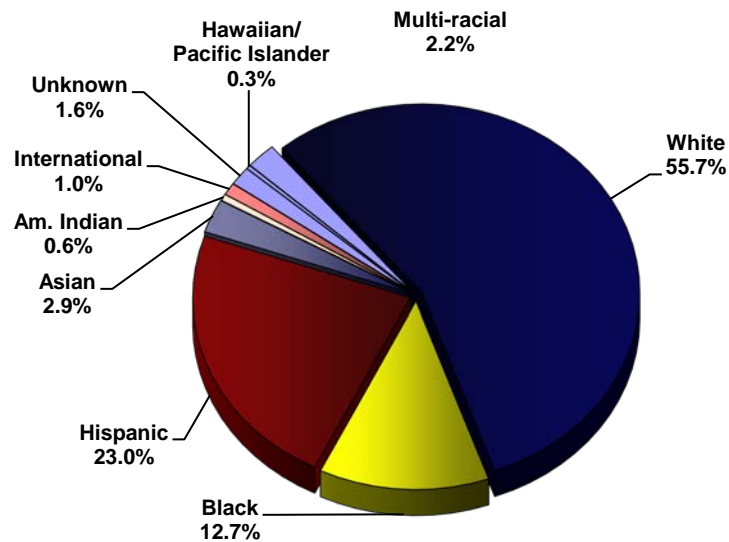


Total HSH: Semester Credit Hour Trends

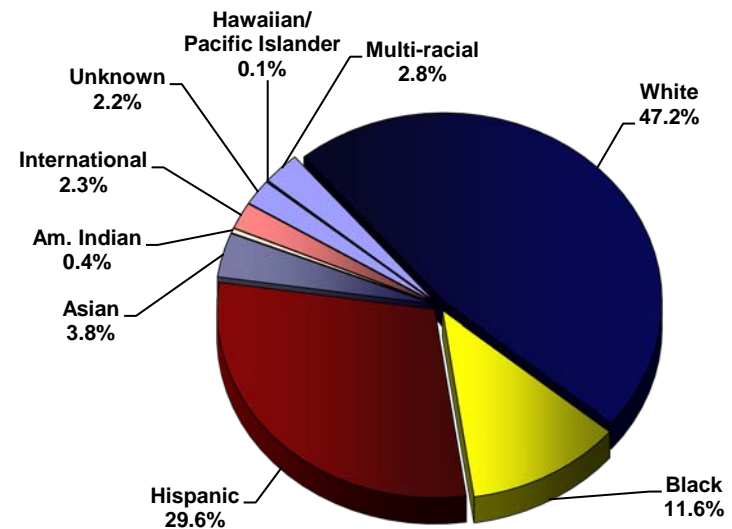

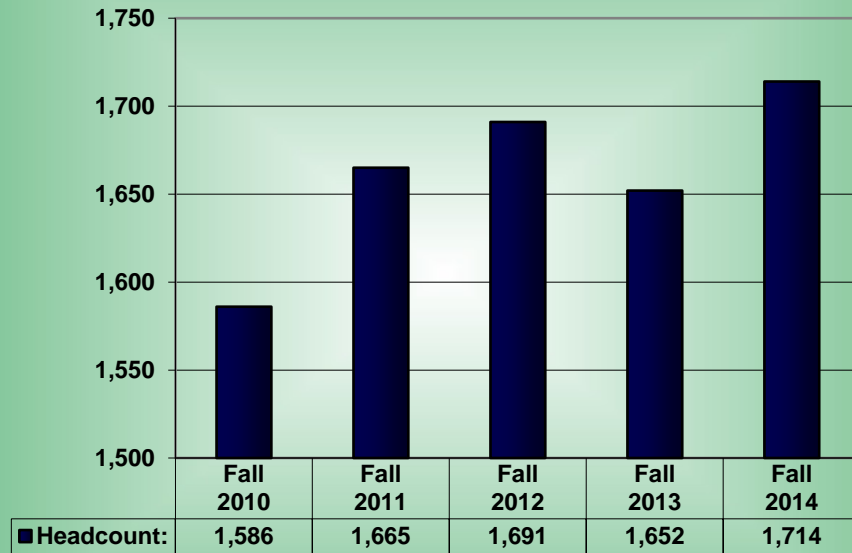

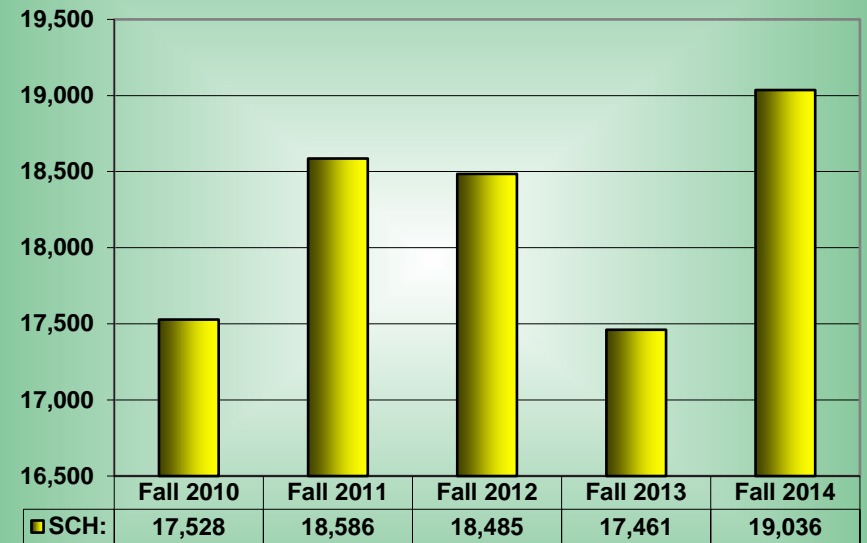

Total HSH Undergraduate: Headcount Trends

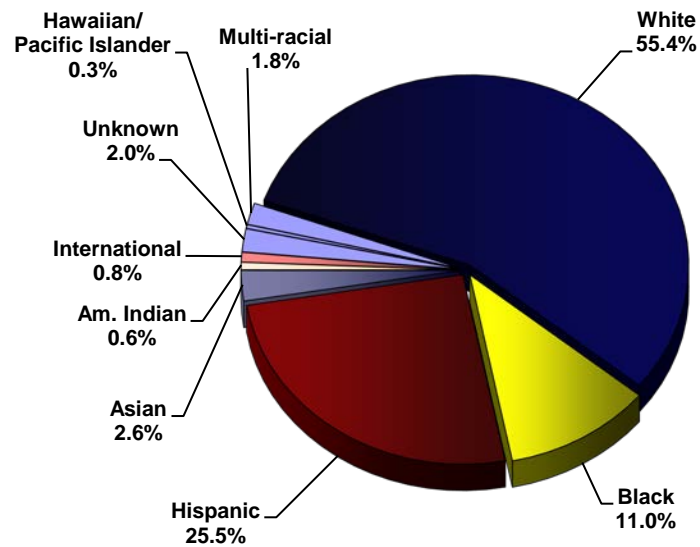


Total HSH Undergraduate: Semester Credit Hour Trends

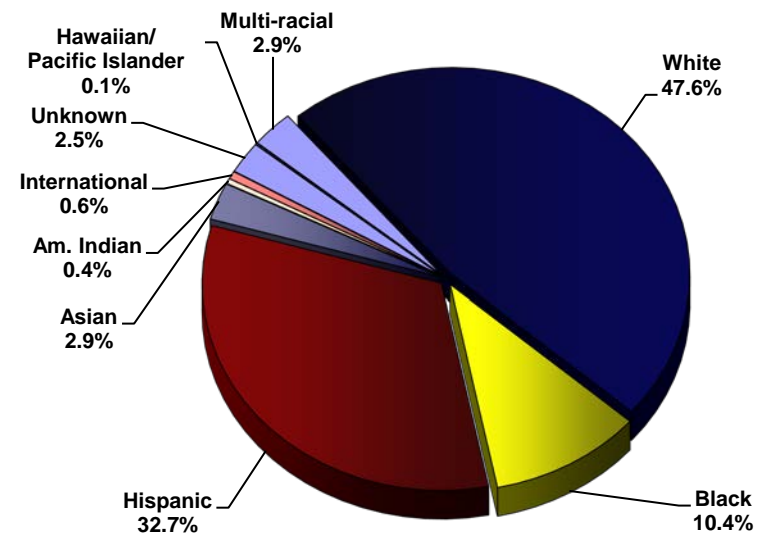

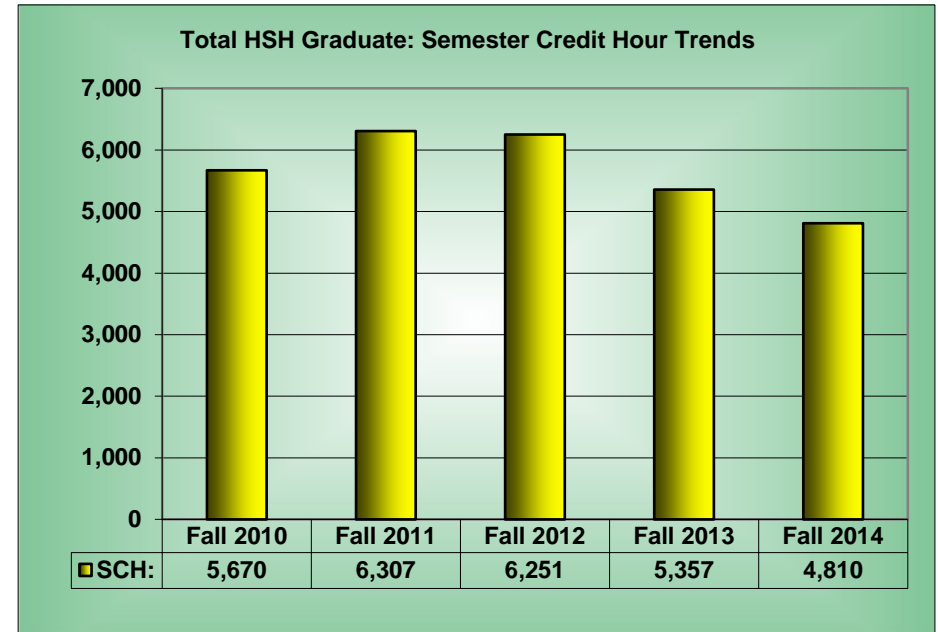

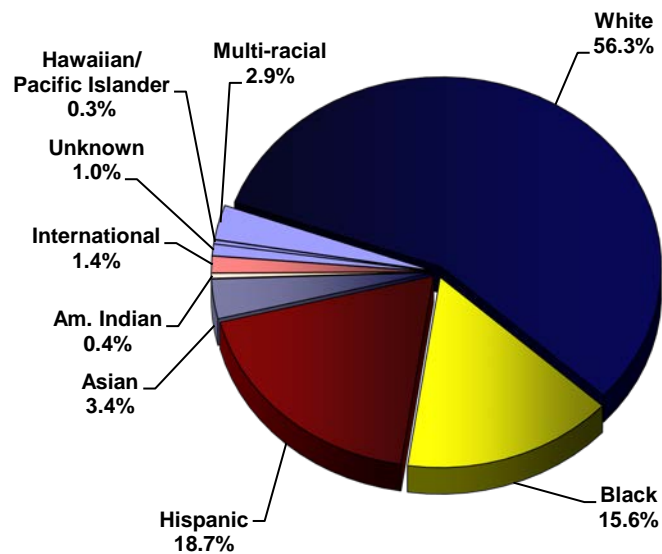

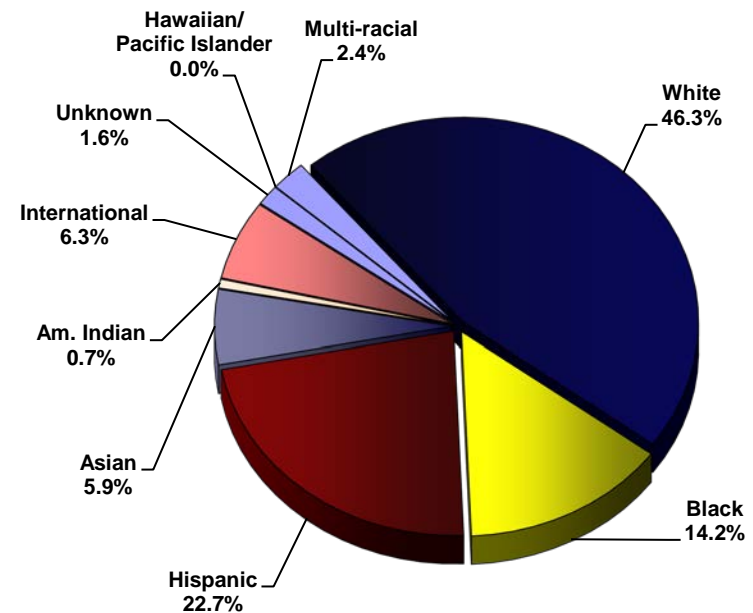

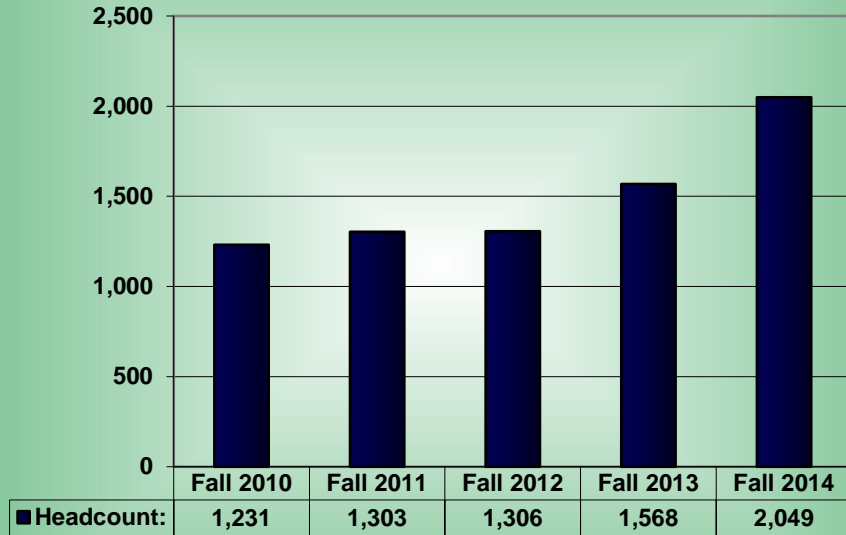

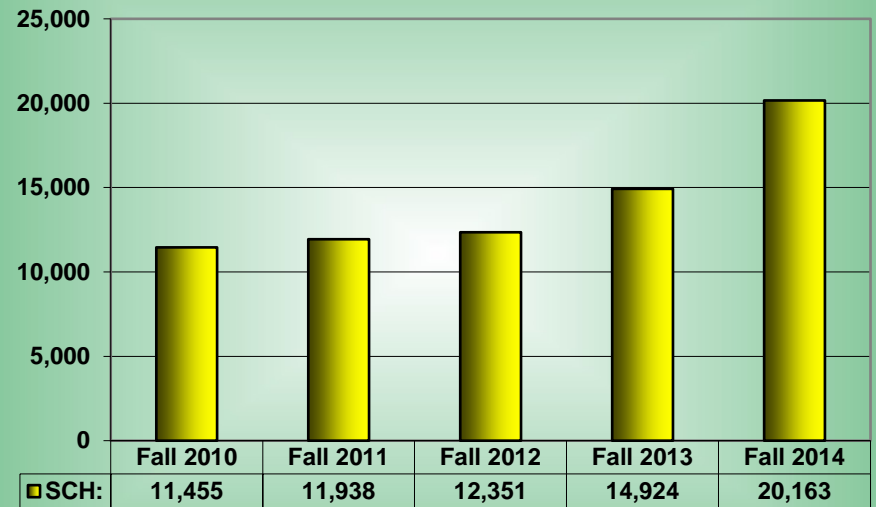

Total SCE: Headcount Trends

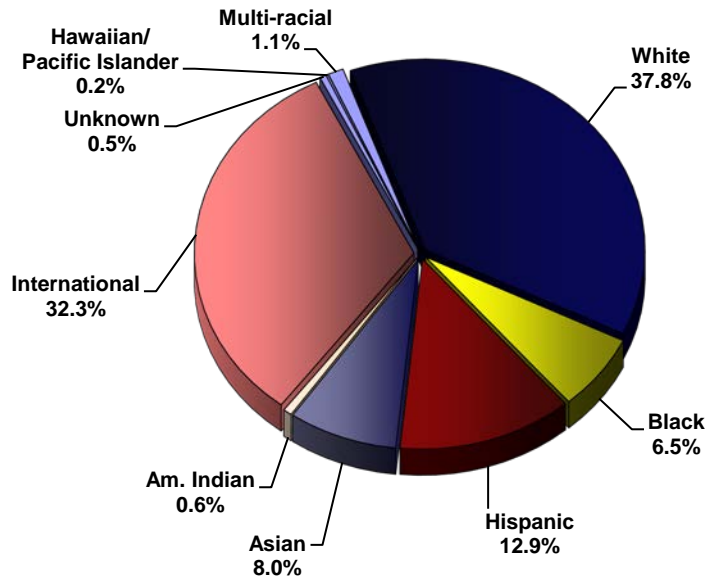


Total SCE: Semester Credit Hour Trends

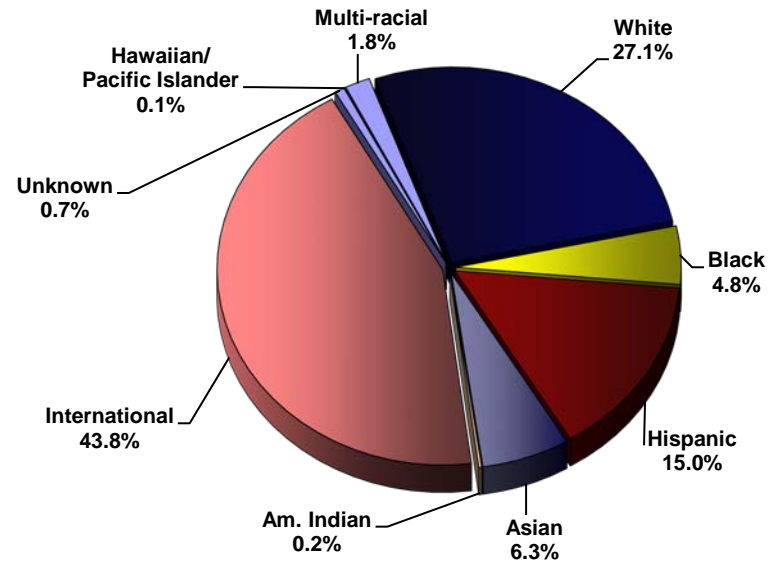

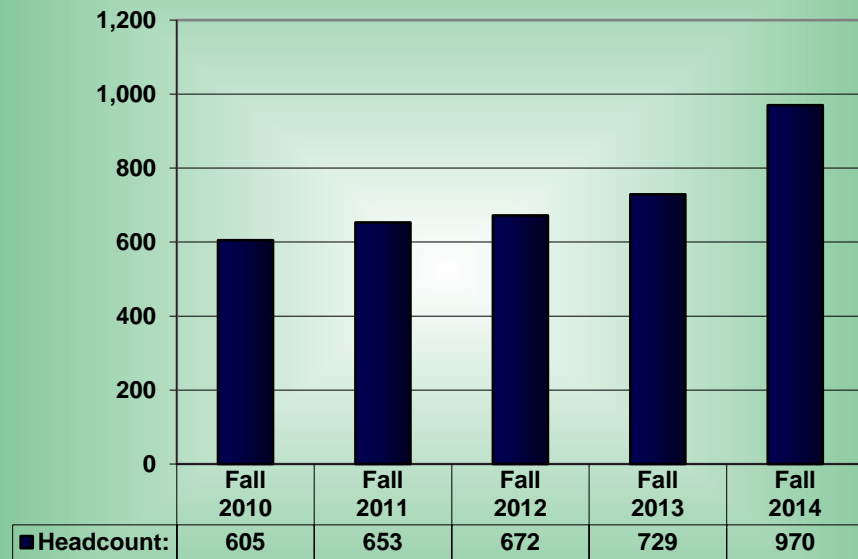

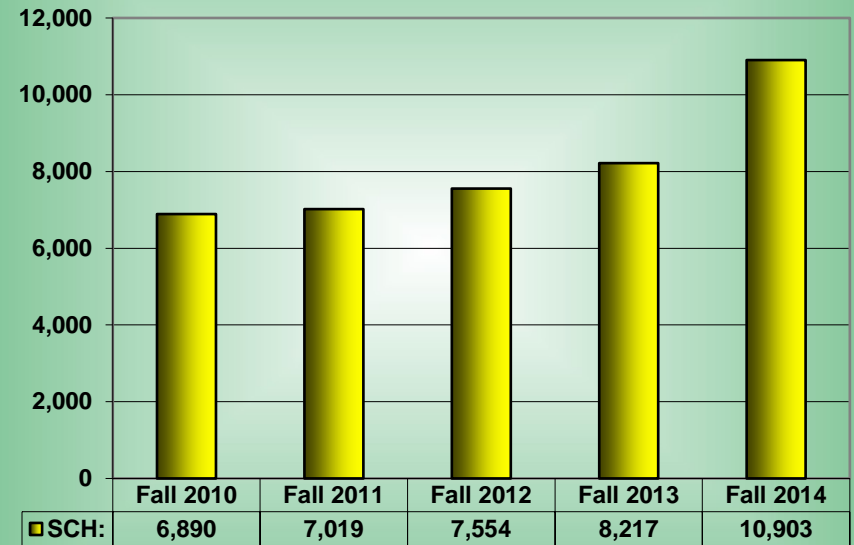

Total SCE Undergraduate: Headcount Trends

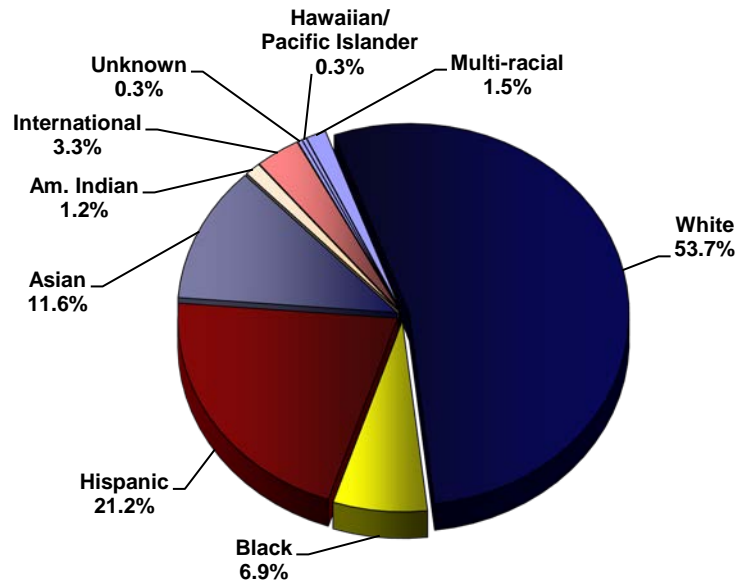


Total SCE Undergraduate: Semester Credit Hour Trends

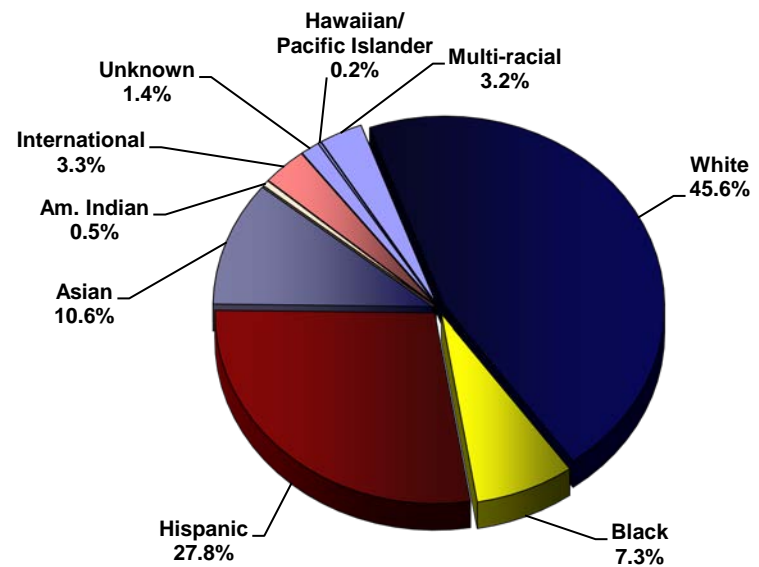

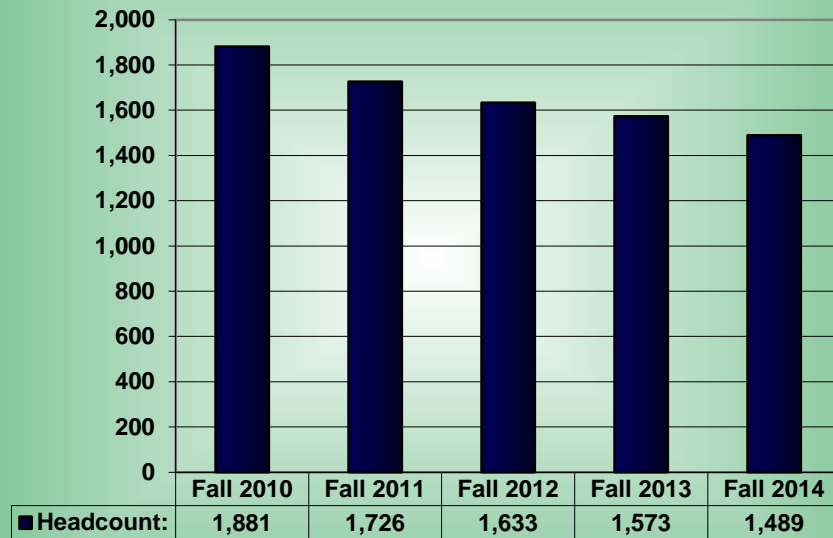
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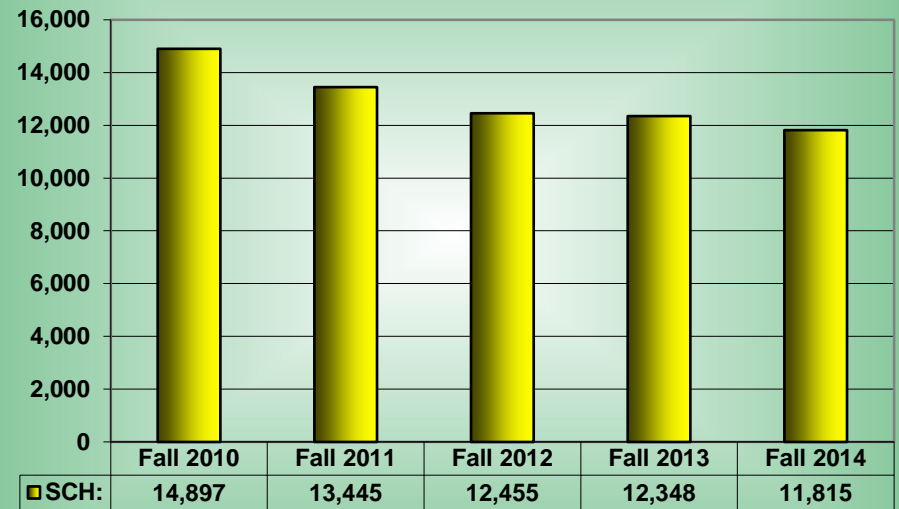

Total SOE: Headcount Trends

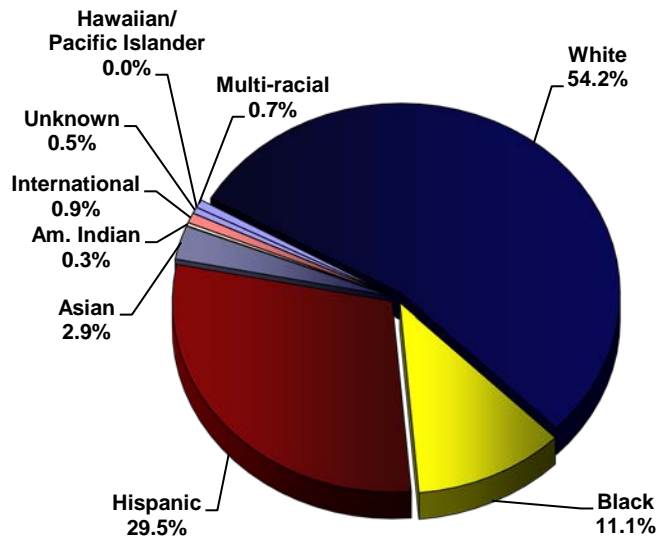


Total SOE: Semester Credit Hour Trends

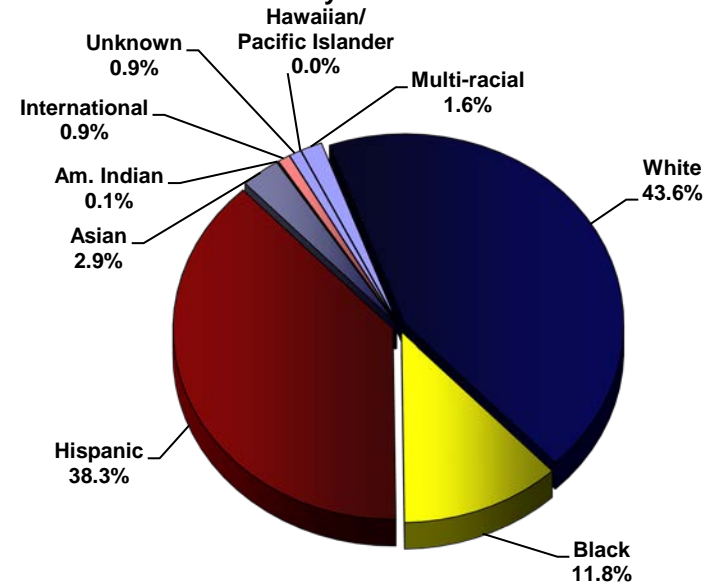

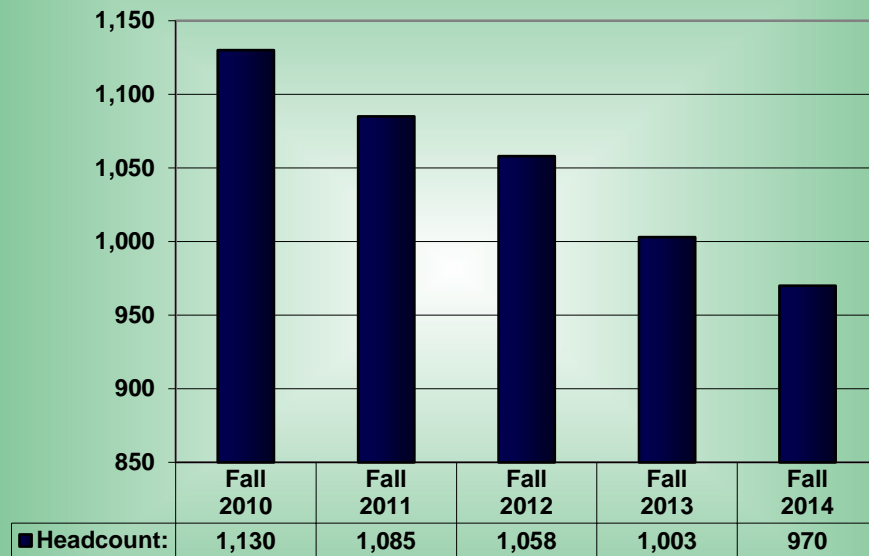

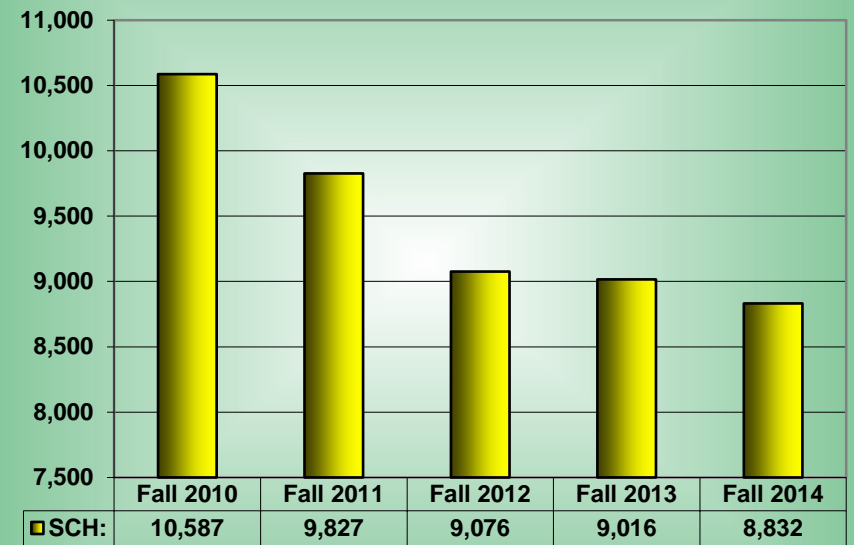

Total SOE Undergraduate: Headcount Trends

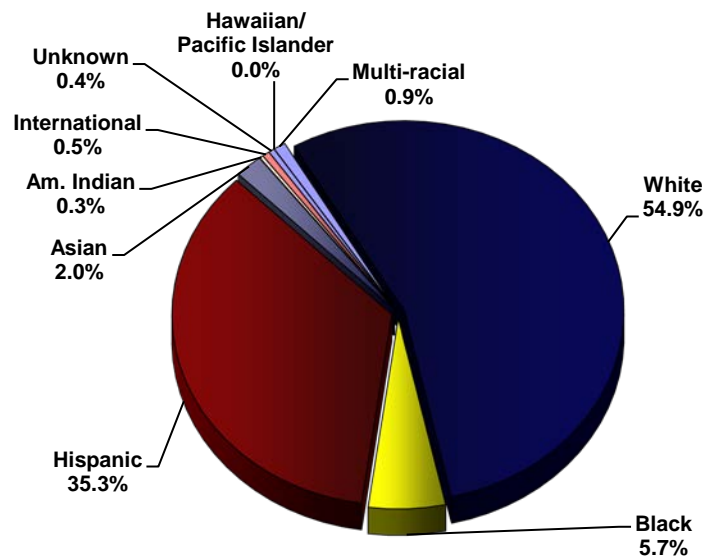


Total SOE Undergraduate: Semester Credit Hour Trends

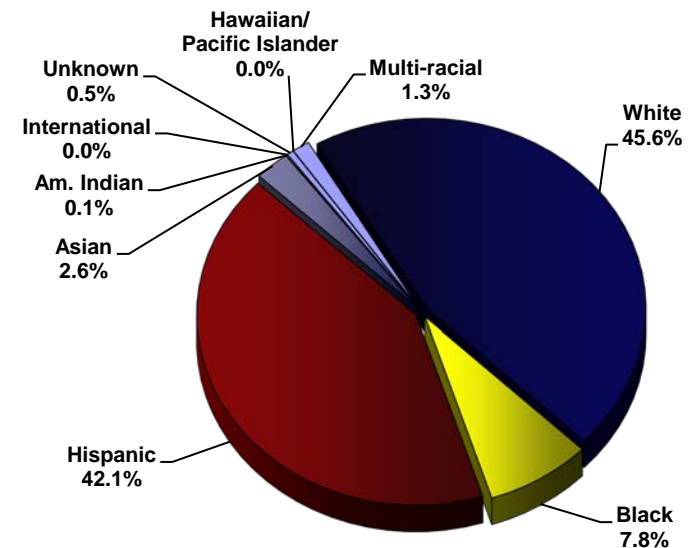

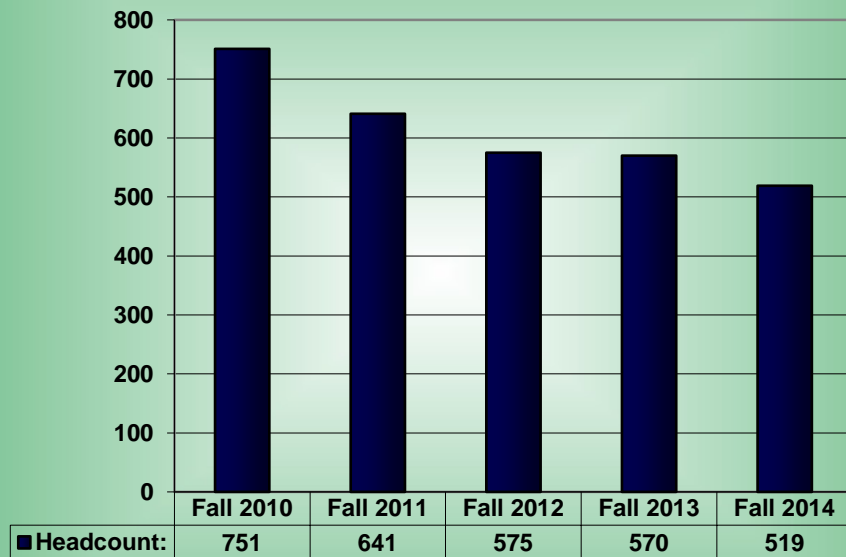

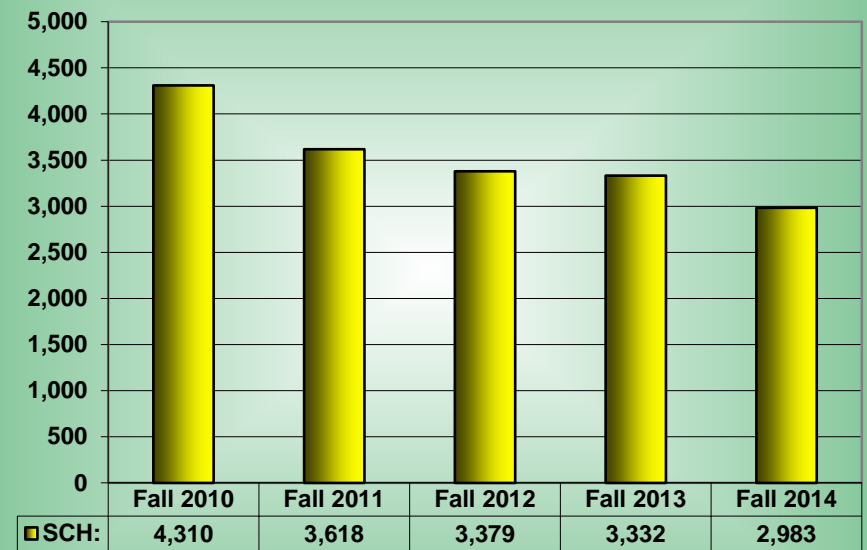

Total SOE Graduate: Headcount Trends

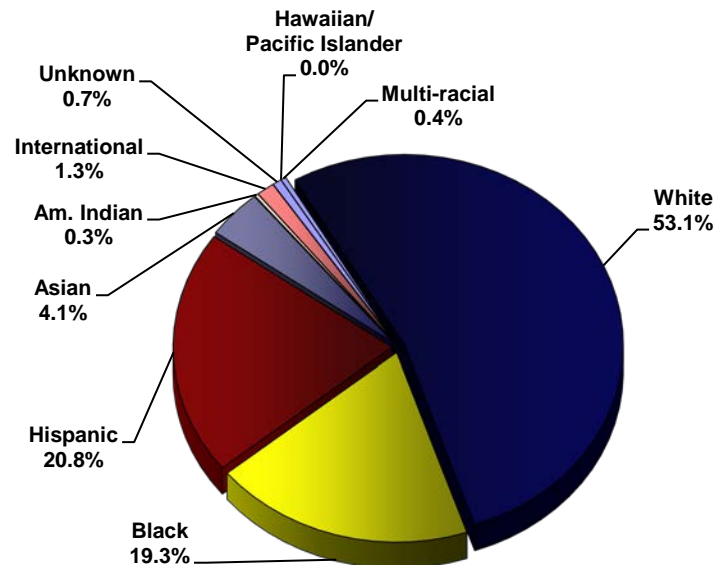


Total SOE Graduate: Semester Credit Hour Trends

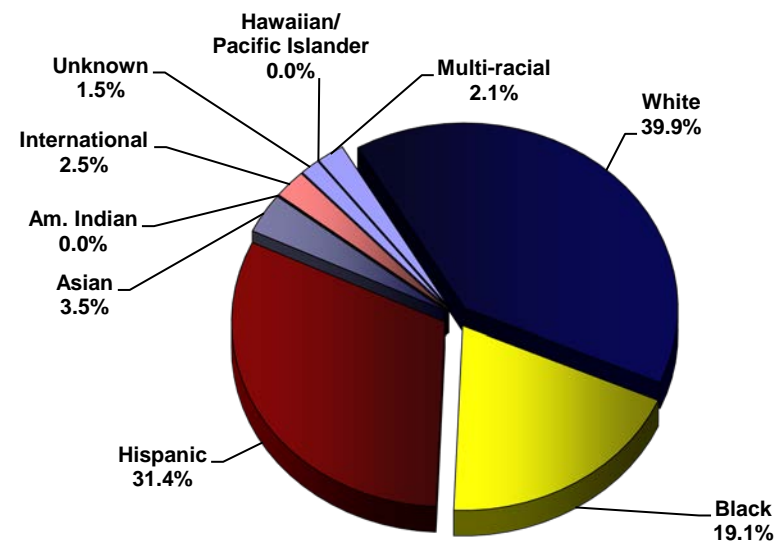
