Acquisition Information

Nassau Bay Garden Club members Ann Davidson and Geraldine Higgs contacted the UHCL Archives to discuss the Garden Club records housed in a self-storage storage facility on Kirby Road near NASA Rd. 1. On October 21, 2010, UHCL archivist Shelly Kelly met the two ladies at the storage unit and seven boxes of records were picked up and brought to UHCL for preservation.

Separate Material

The 1977-1978 Club scrapbook came to the UHCL Archives after sustaining water damage, and contained mold. It was scanned, and the original was removed from the collection. The scanned version of the scrapbook is available from UHCL Archives staff in a PDF document.

Arrangement

The collection is arranged based on the purpose and format of the materials into boxes and folders. The collection is grouped into thirteen series, with folders are arranged by date. The Club's original scrapbooks are housed in large oversized boxes at the end of the collection.

Biographical/Historical Note

The Nassau Bay Garden Club was first formed by four neighbors who gathered for coffee one morning in August 1964, when the idea of a garden club was formed. Jane Neely's kitchen table was where the discussion occurred that led to the first meeting of the club less than a month later in Nassau Bay, Texas. The Nassau Bay Garden Club was chartered in 1964, and is one of the oldest organizations in Nassau Bay. The first year saw 23 charter members with close to 50 members by the end of the first year. The pansy was adopted that year as the club's flower, with blue and gold as the club's colors.

During the 1965-1966 year, the Garden Club was accepted into the Houston Federation of Garden Clubs, Inc. Its "Yard of the Month" awards and first flower shows were instituted around this time. Also in the late 1960s, the Nassau Bay Garden Club began their Christmas programming, which included an annual Christmas Tour of Homes; the judging of outdoor Christmas light displays; and the planting and lighting of a memorial Christmas tree in honor of astronaut Roger Chaffee, who died in the Apollo 1 spacecraft fire in 1967.

The Nassau Bay Garden Club expanded its work to include Arbor Day tree plantings; the beautification of NASA Road 1 that runs along the NASA Manned Spacecraft Center in Houston; donations of litter barrels and money; and plantings of other shrubs and flowers at Nassau Bay establishments. The Garden Club elects and appoints board and committee officers every year, and membership is open to any resident of the city of Nassau Bay, Texas.

Scope and Content

The collection is composed of the original records of the Nassau Bay Garden Club of the city of Nassau Bay, Texas. The records in the collection include club history records, budgets, correspondence, meetings minutes, membership lists, publications, club president's notebooks, project files, fundraising records, reports, scrapbooks, and other materials. Such materials in the collection include project files detailing the operation of the Club's Yard of the Month competition and fundraisers. The Club's original newsletters "Bloomin' Notes" and "Blossoming Notes" document the work done from 1994 to 2008.

The largest set of materials in the collection are the original Club scrapbooks, dating back to 1971 and running through 1999. The scrapbooks contain fliers, clippings, artwork, and photographs documenting the activities of the Nassau Bay Garden Club.
