








Total UHCL Ethnicity: Summer 2012










Total UHCL Undergraduate Ethnicity: Summer 2012










Total BUS Ethnicity: Summer 2012






Total BUS Undergraduate Ethnicity: Summer 2012










Total BUS Graduate Ethnicity: Summer 2012










Total HSH Ethnicity: Summer 2012








Total HSH Undergraduate Ethnicity: Summer 2012




























Total SOE Undergraduate Ethnicity: Summer 2012




