# **Biographical/Historical Note (545)**

James Sherrill, a native Texan, was born and raised in Austin and graduated from the University of Texas with a doctoral degree in mathematics education.

He joined UH-Clear Lake's School of Education as the Associate Dean in July 1999 after serving 29 years at the University of British Columbia in various capacities, including Associate Dean for Administration, Associate Dean for Graduate Programs and Research, as well as the Associate Director of Graduate Programs.

Sherrill's list of accomplishments include: winning the 2009 Christa McAuliffe Award for Excellence in Teacher Education; having its Pre-Service Internship I and II Program named winner of the Distinguished Program in Teacher Education Award by the Association of Teacher Educators in 2008; receiving flawless re-accreditation in 2007 from the National Council for the Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE); winning approval in 2006 to implement a doctoral program at a time when there was a moratorium on such programs; plus receiving multiple large training grants allowing UH-Clear Lake to train bilingual teachers, administrators, counselors and librarians.

He retired from UHCL on July 31, 2010
