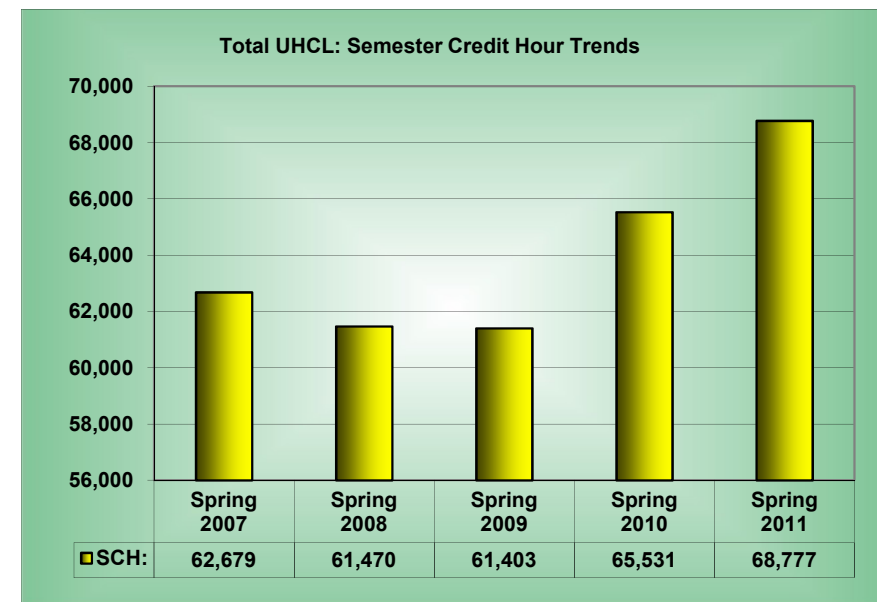

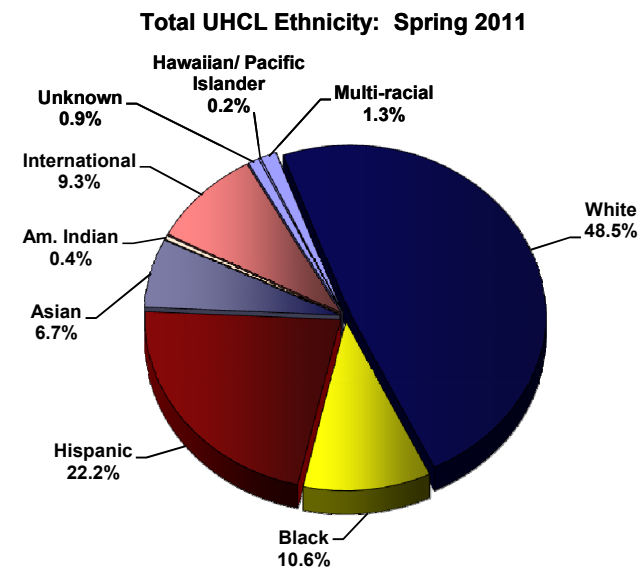
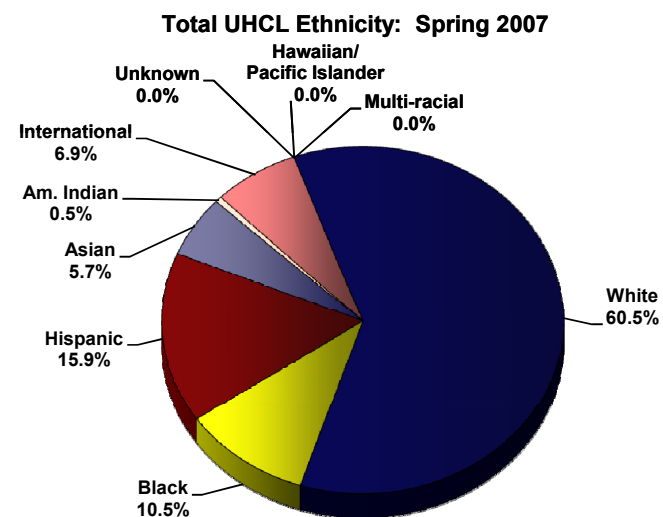

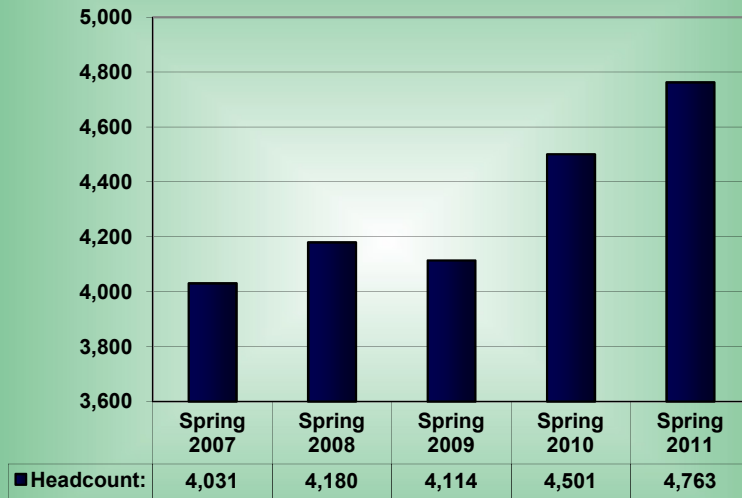

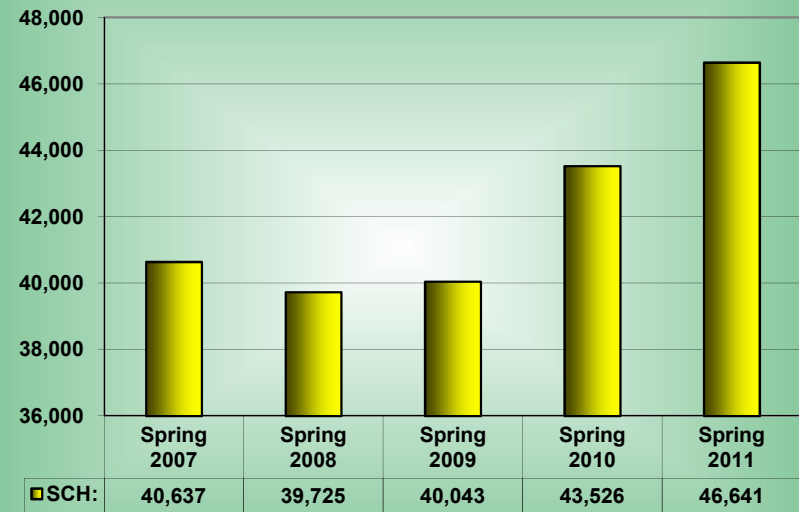

Total UHCL Undergraduate: Headcount Trends

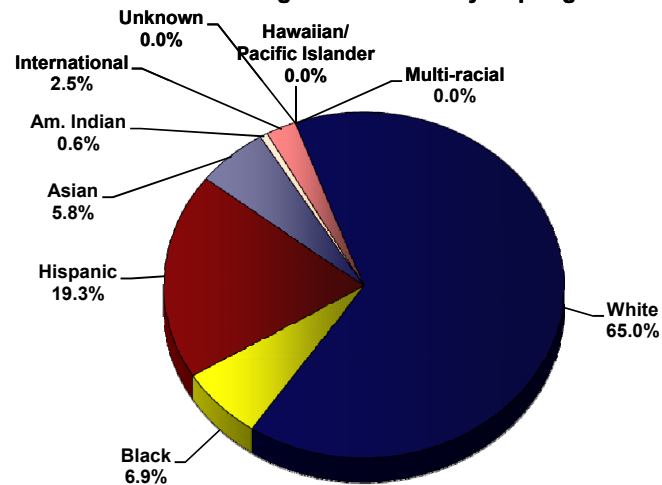

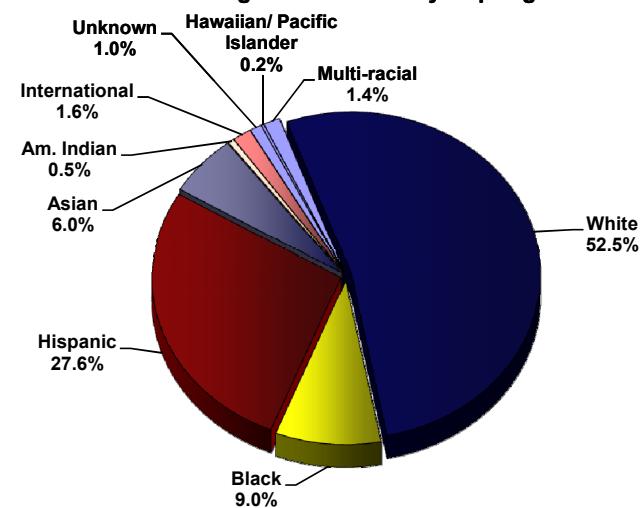
Total UHCL Undergraduate: Semester Credit Hour Trends

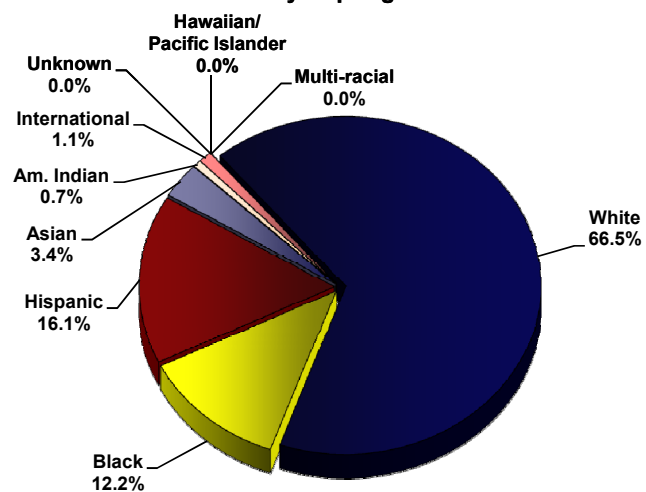

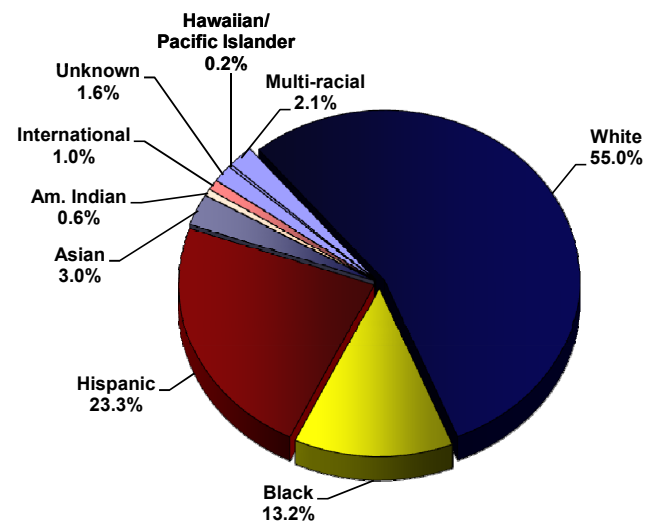

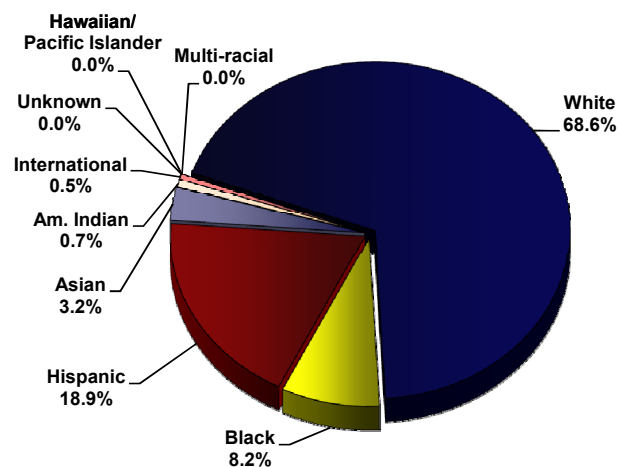

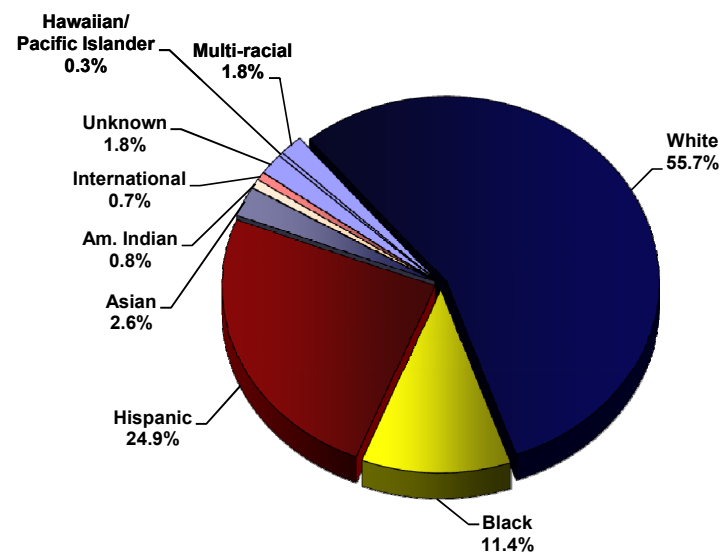

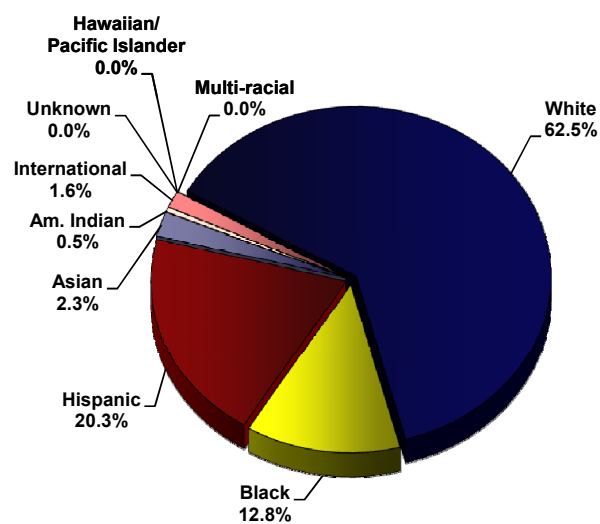

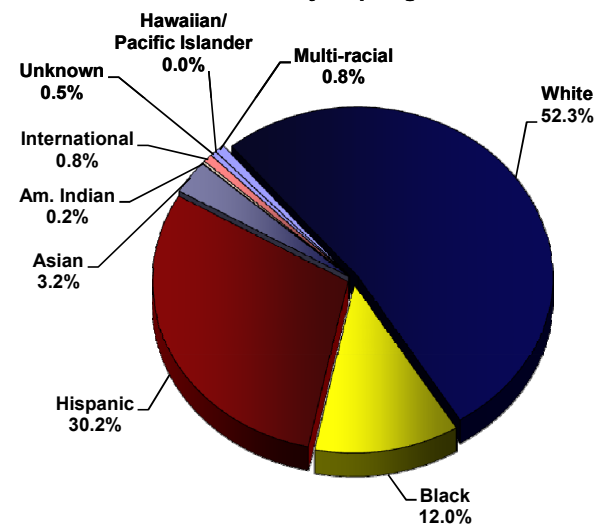

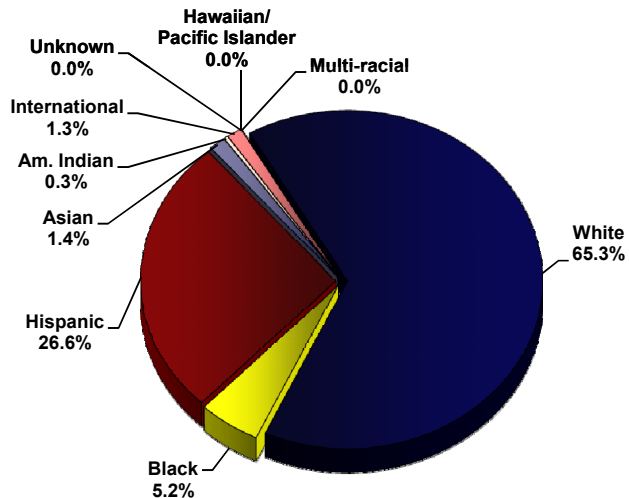

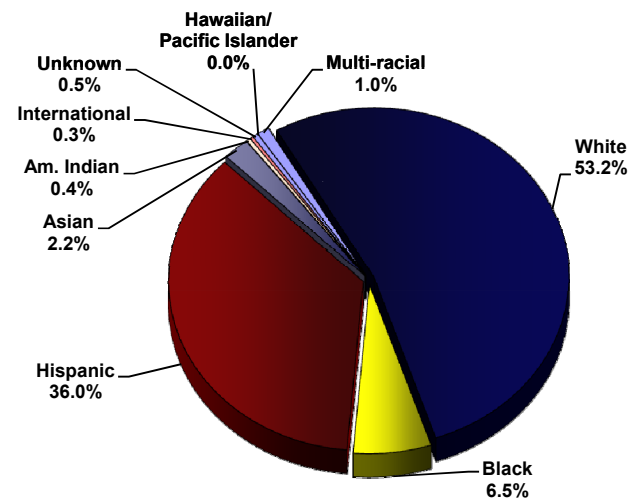

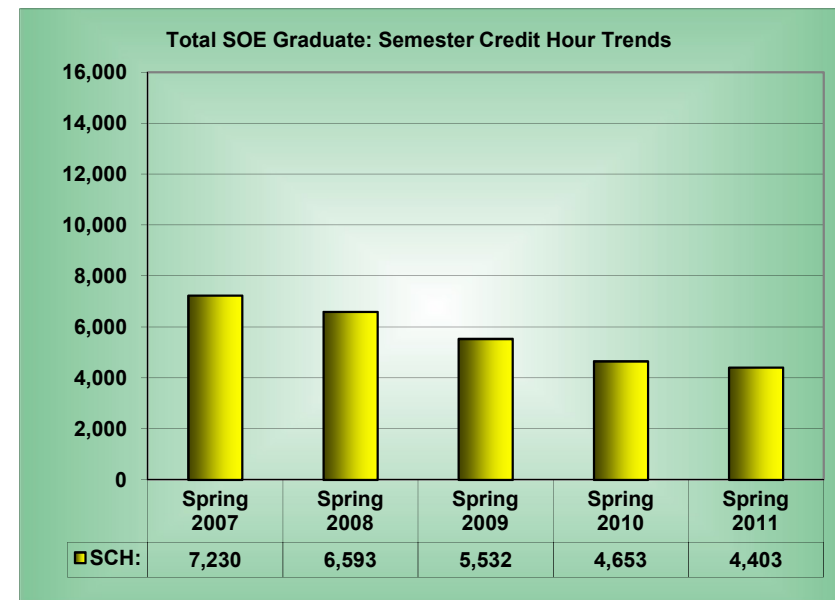

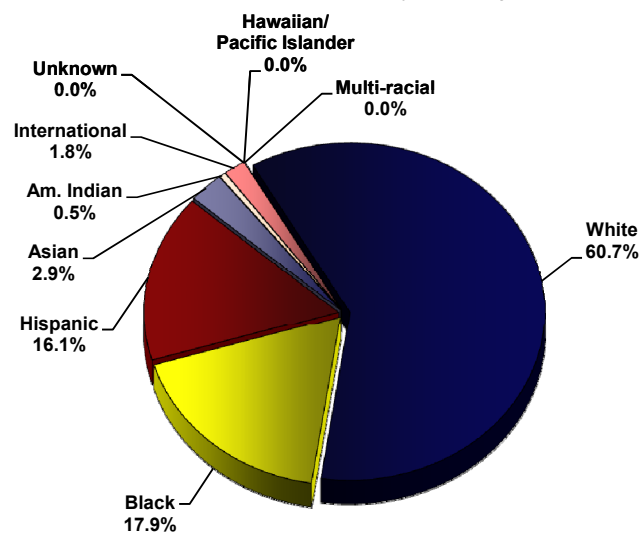

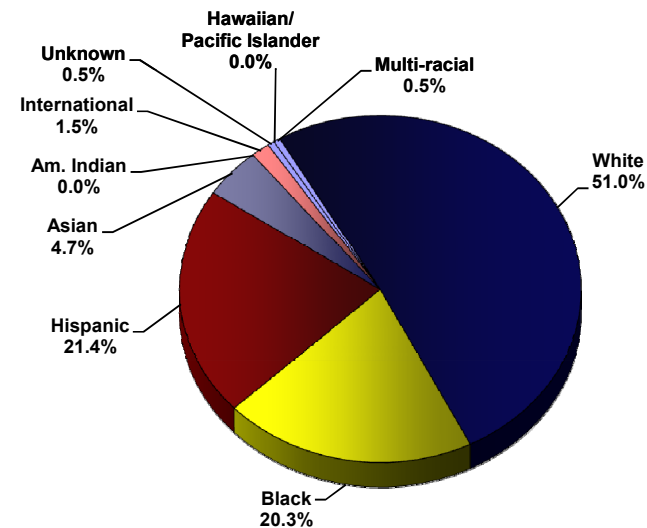
