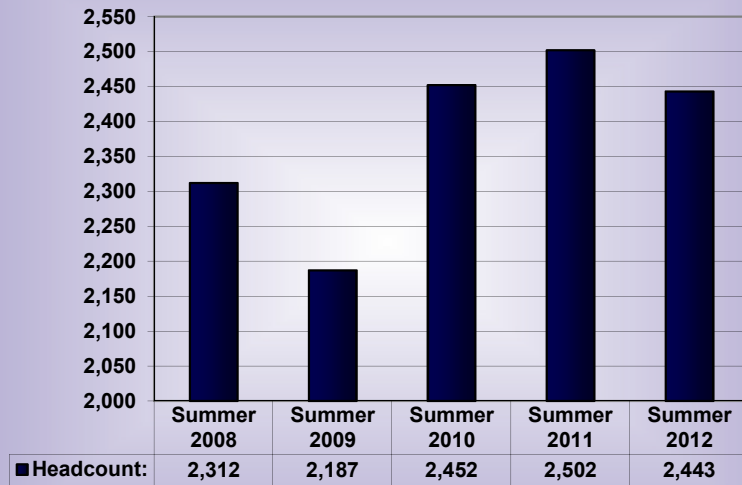

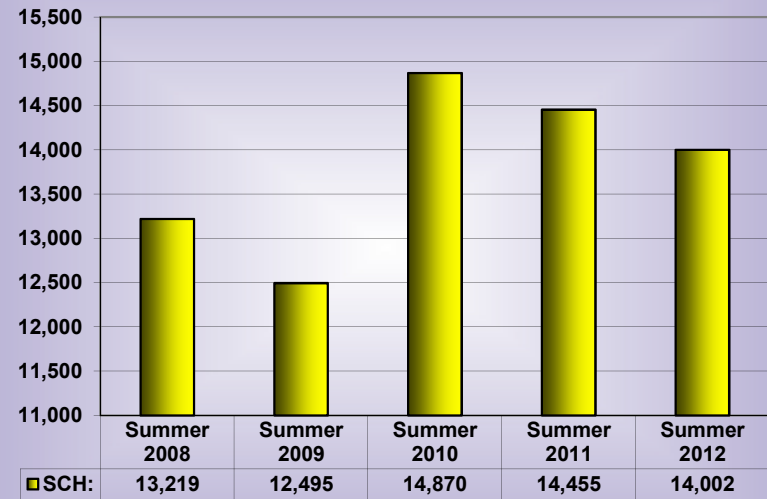

Total UHCL Undergraduate: Headcount Trends

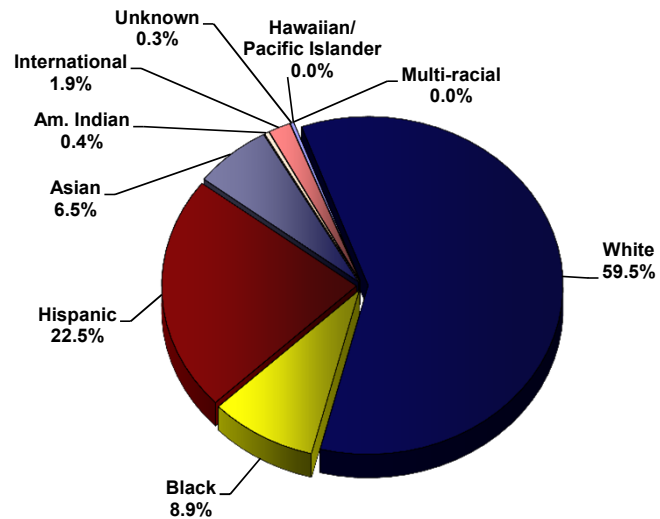


Total UHCL Undergraduate: Semester Credit Hour Trends

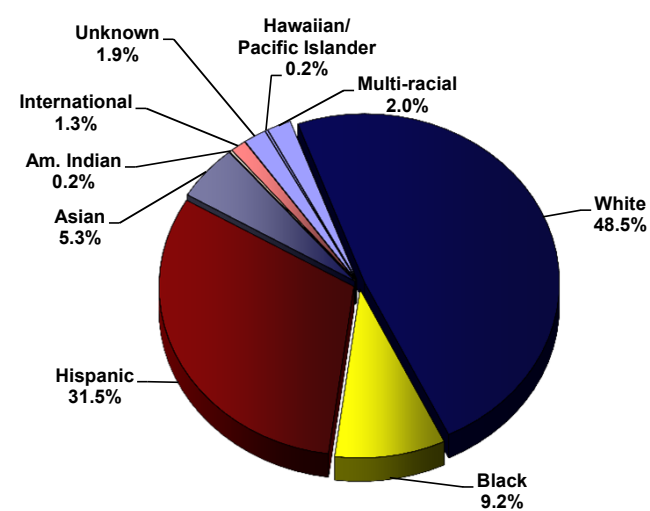

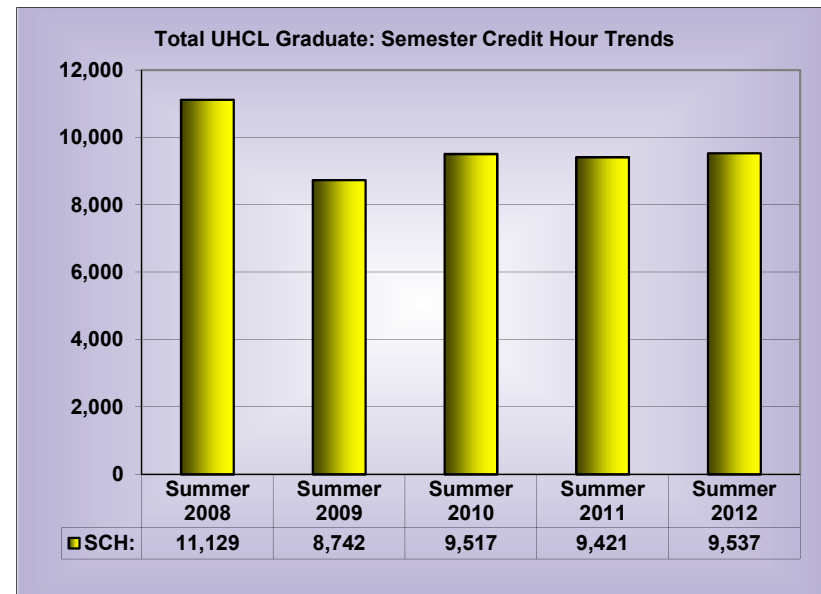

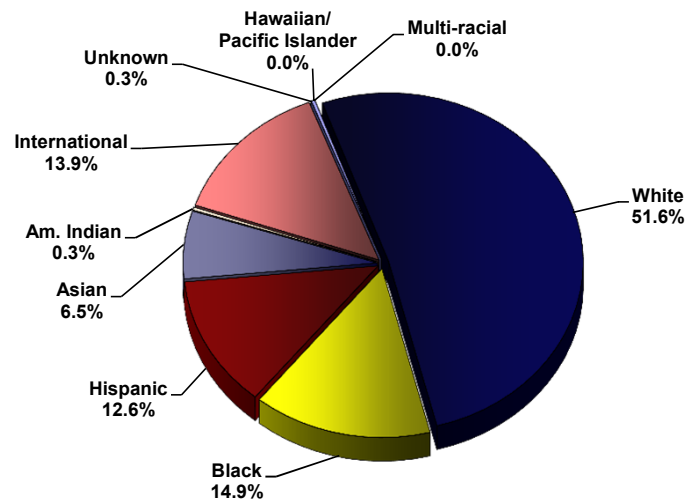

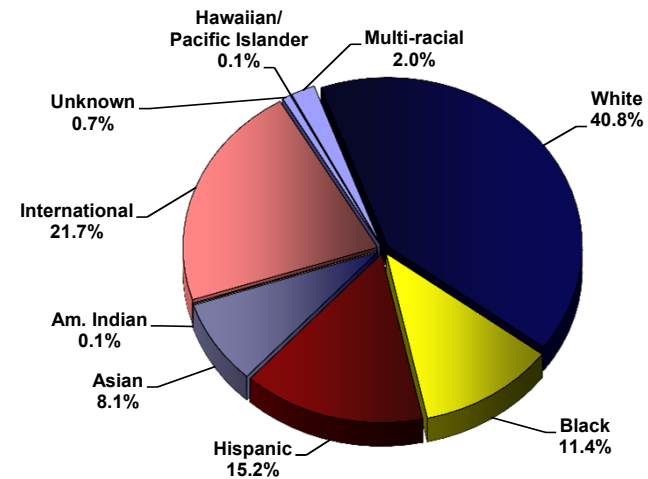

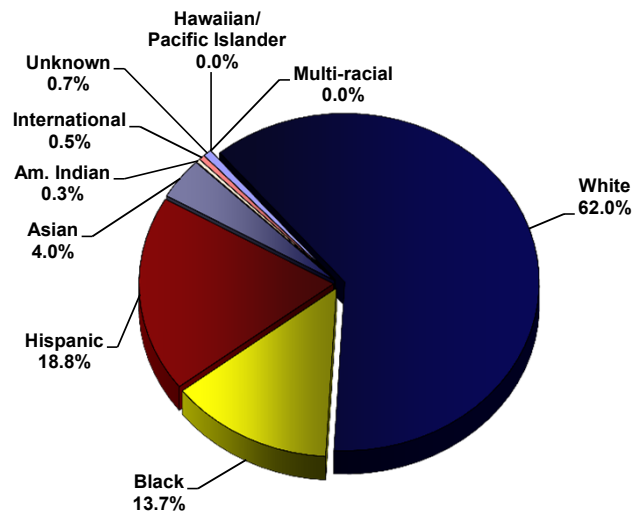

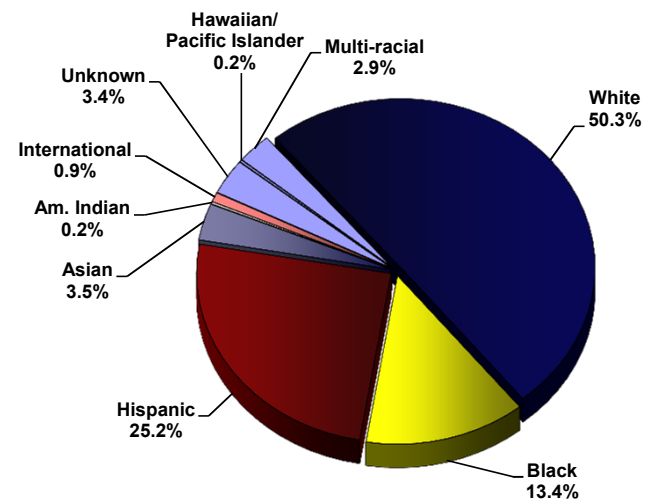

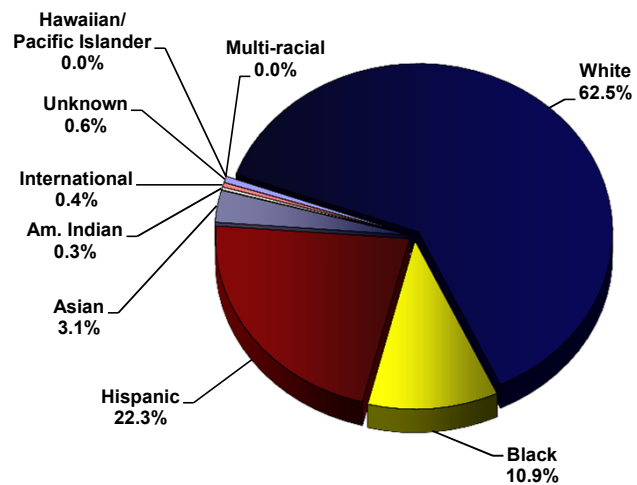

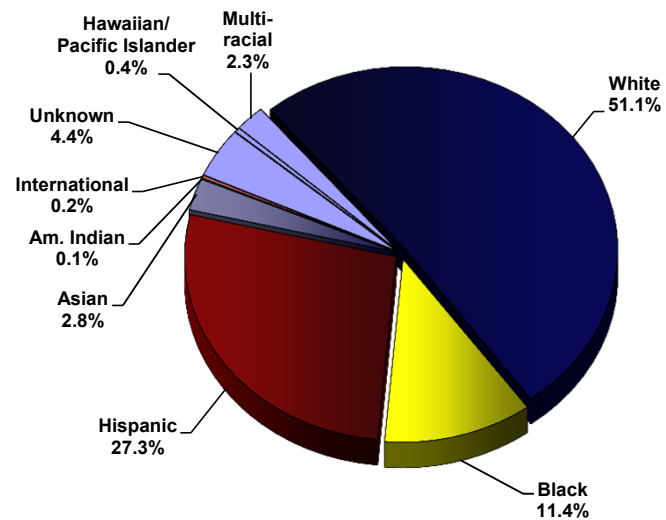

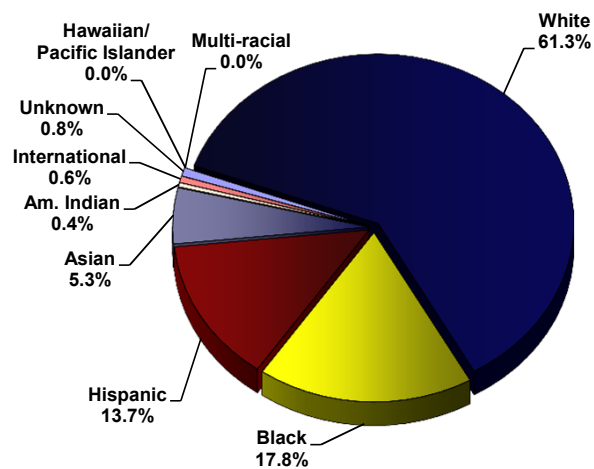

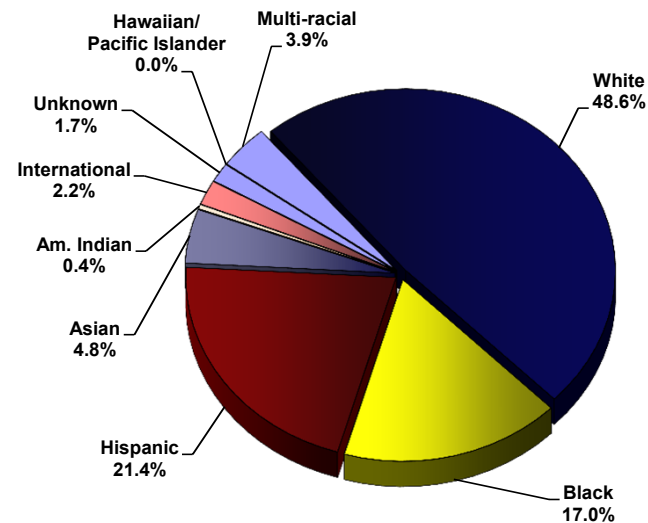

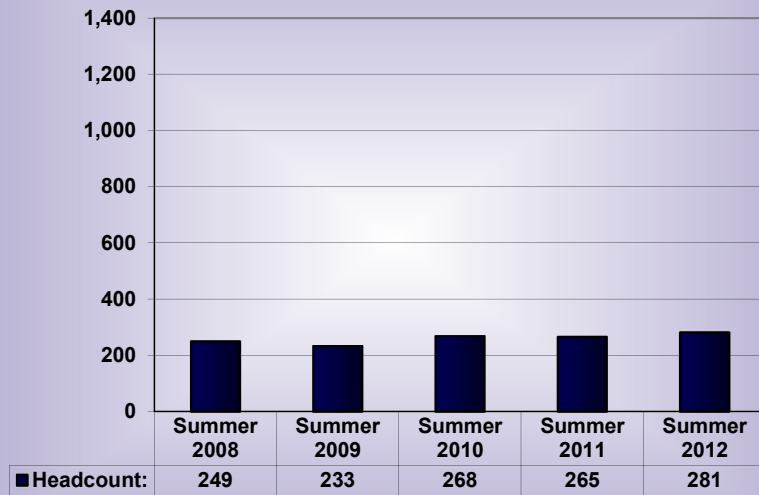

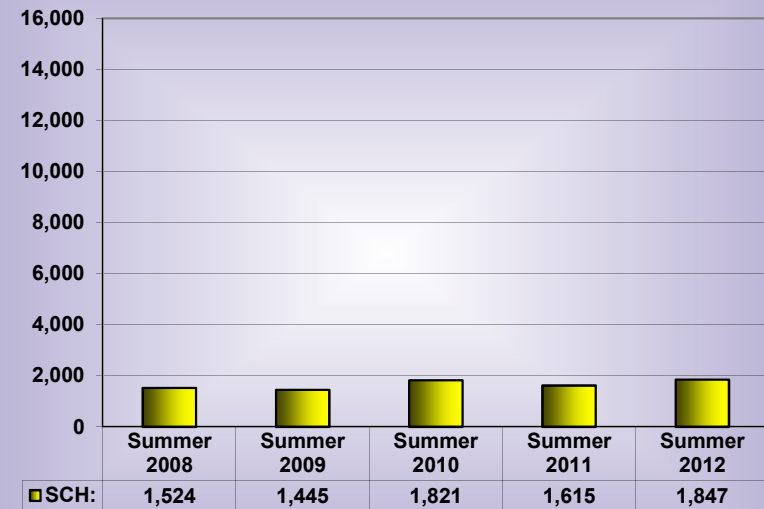

Total SCE Undergraduate: Headcount Trends

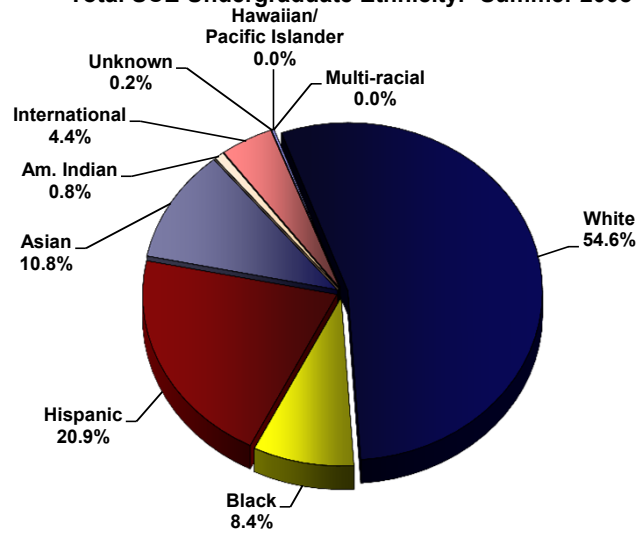


Total SCE Undergraduate: Semester Credit Hour Trends

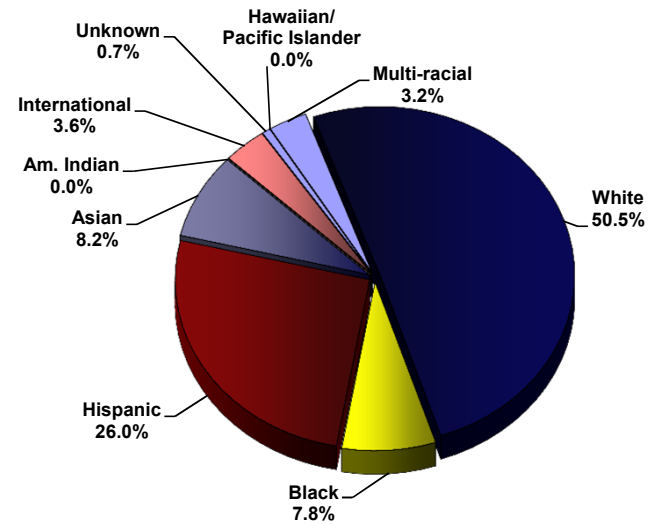

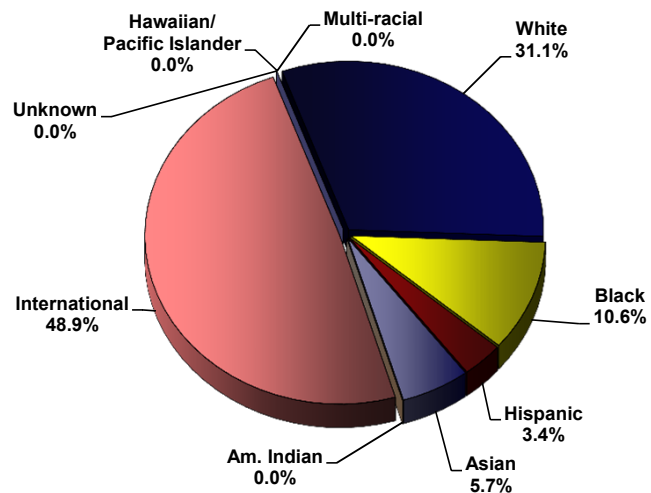

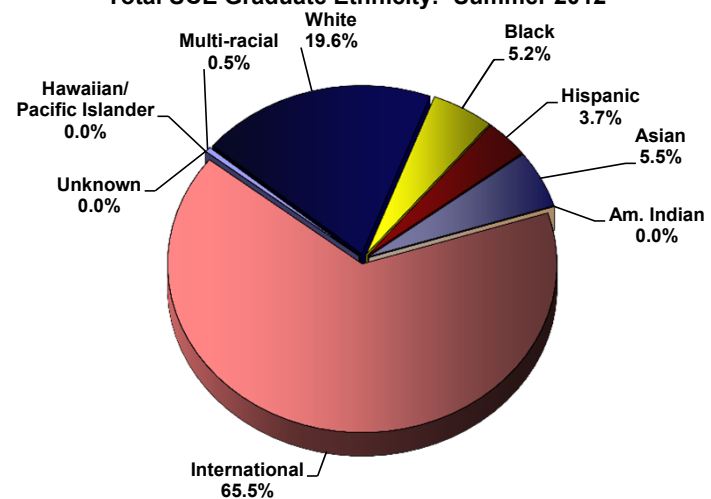

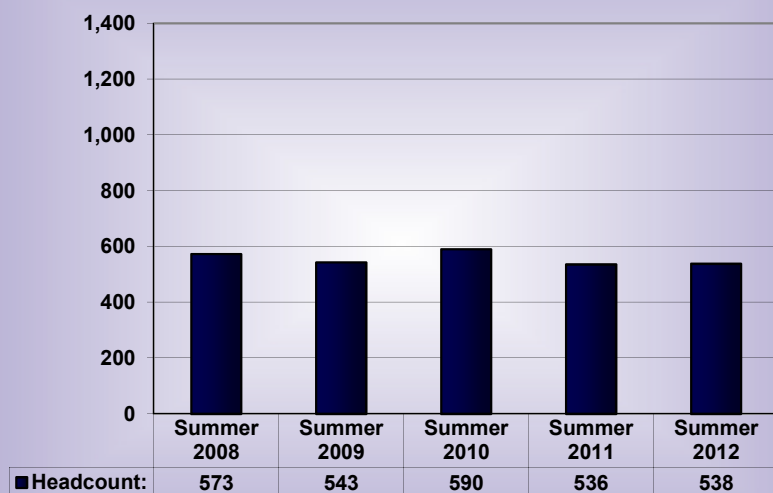

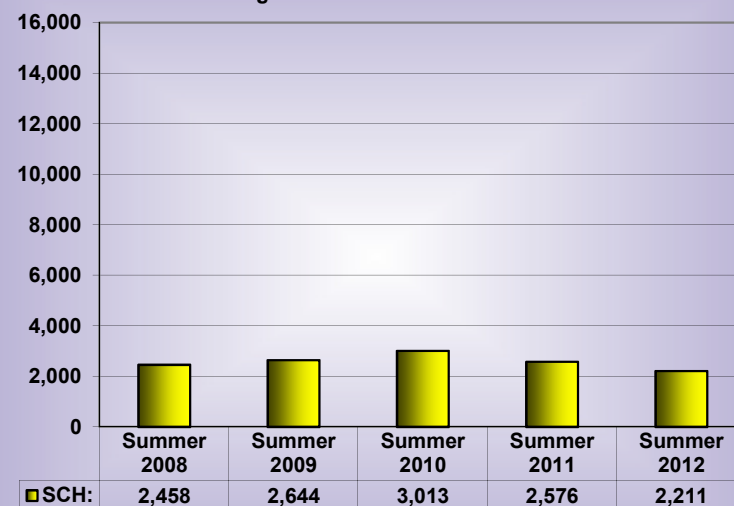

Total SOE Undergraduate: Headcount Trends

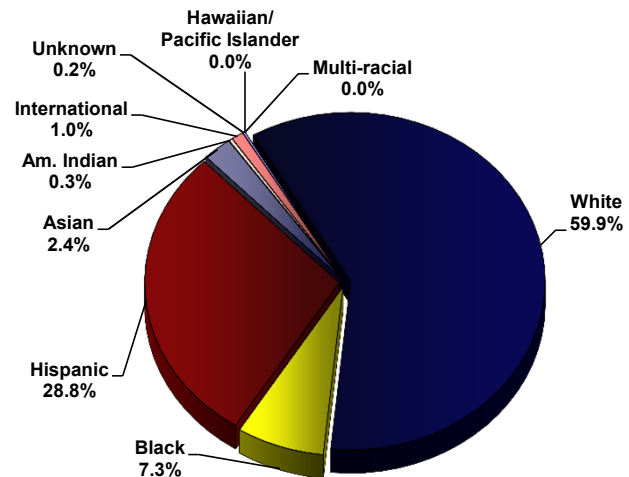


Total SOE Undergraduate: Semester Credit Hour Trends

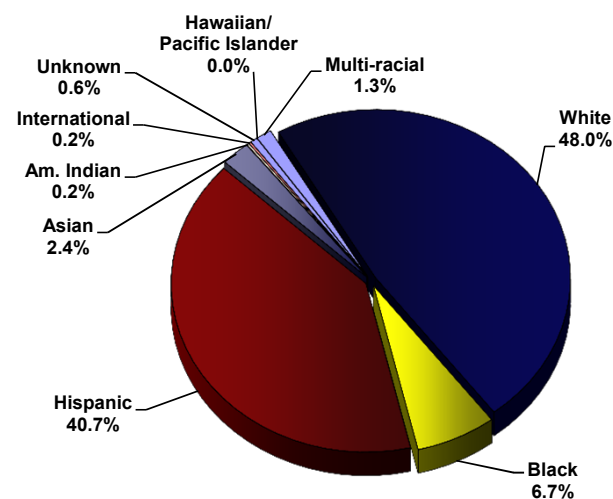

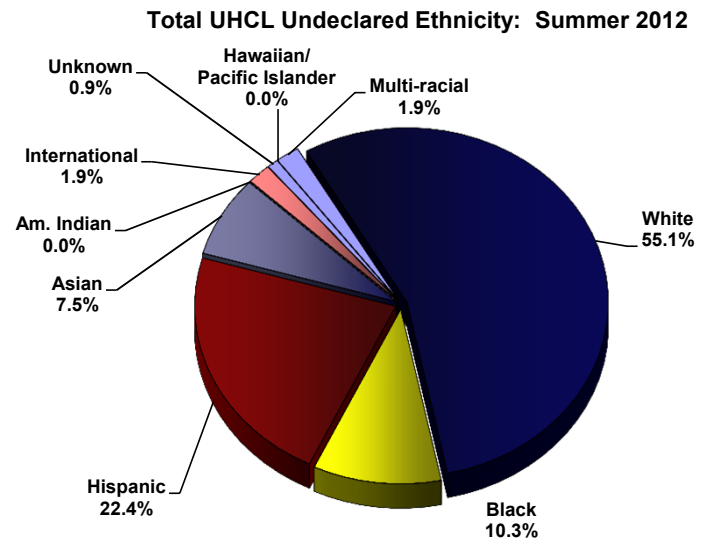
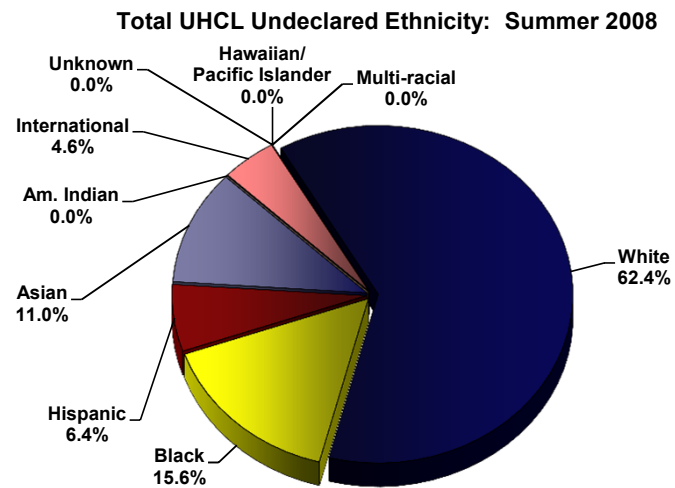
