Biographical/Historical Note

Timber Cove Garden Club formed in 1963, with the first meetings being held in 1964. Officers were elected, policies and by-laws written, programs planned, and meetings held within the homes of its members. Dues were originally set at \$3.00 per year and membership was open to all ladies in Timber Cove. In 1990, membership was later opened to Lake Country residents. The objectives of the club were to foster friendships among neighbors, enhance community awareness, and provide educational and cultural opportunities to its members.

Scope and Content

This is a collection of Timber Cove Garden records. It includes founding and historical documents, correspondence, programs and events, local publications, newspaper clippings, photographs (loose ones and ones taken from photo albums), and scrapbooks. The SEEDS Project folder contains seeds used by NASA for its space experiments.

Arrangement

Records as delivered included scrapbooks, binders, loose documents, loose photos, and one unlabeled, undated photo album. Scrapbooks were housed in oversized boxes. Loose documents were artificially grouped by like items. Loose photos were placed in archival envelopes. Photos in the album were numbered and the plastic sleeves removed from the binder. Photos falling out of torn plastic sleeves were numbered and grouped in envelopes.

Historical documents were originally housed in two large binders in plastic page protectors. The earliest documents appear to have been removed from a Vice President's notebook that survived a fire, flood, and two hurricanes. These documents were filed in loose chronological order and consist of minutes and agendas, correspondence, reports, and various brochures. They were kept in their original order.

Items Separated

For best preservation practice, photos were removed from magnetic photo albums and the albums were discarded. Original news clippings were copied onto acid-free paper and originals were tossed. Documents originally housed in binders were removed and placed into acid-free folders; binders were discarded. Non-archival plastic sleeves were removed from the documents. Sticky notes were removed from photos and identifying information was transferred onto the backs of the photos using archival-safe pencils.

Programs for the years 1964-1972 were removed from the collection and discarded due to high mold content, most likely stemming from water damage sustained to a member's home during a hurricane.
