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

Thanks for your email and congratulations on being so close to finishing.

As I recall one of my terms was that the scale was not reproduced in full until I had published my own article on its creation and the scale in full. Unfortunately due to some issues out of our control we have not been able to finalise a version to be submitted to be published, yet — we anticipate this to be in the next few months.

Therefore I do not give my permission for you to publish the scale in full in your thesis.

I will allow you to publish the scale in full in your thesis as it is submitted to the markers only, but only on the terms that it is marked as 'Confidential' and your markers are asked not distribute your thesis to any party other than the markers (which I imagine is the usual terms), that the full scale must be deleted in the final version you publish in any kind of online or library repository, and that you send me the final version of your thesis to be published online prior to it going live online or in the library.

Perhaps you can remove the scale in your appendix for your final published version and simply put "Locke Parenting Scale (LPS) - Please contact Dr Judith Locke (judith@judithlocke.com) should you wish to see or use this scale in your own research".

I do not think this is onerous or unusual as it would be highly unusual to publish a scale in full should you not be the author of that scale.

I am a master's student at the University of Houston-Clear Lake completing a thesis in Clinical Psychology. About a year ago, you agreed

to allow our research team, Dr. Thomas Schanding, Dr. Mary Short, and Dr. Sara Elkins, to use the Locke Parenting Scale in a research study. I am using part of that data as my master's thesis project. I wanted to thank you for your permission to use the survey for my study. My study is examining the relationship between helicopter parenting and social emotional learning, in children ages 6 to 11. My research is being supervised by my professor, G. Thomas Schanding Jr., Ph.D.

We have used the Locke Parenting Scale in its entirety. The Locke Parenting Scale was used to measure parents' self-report beliefs, attitudes, and behaviors that may contribute to overparenting. The Locke Parenting Scale was one of the many measures that parents were asked to fill out after they filled out a pre-screener and the consent form on Qualtrics. All data was entered into and analyzed using SPSS.

The University's library is asking that I obtain your written permission to reproduce the LPS in my thesis appendix. The thesis will be published in the UHCL Institutional Repository at <https://uhcl-ir.tdl.org/uhcl-ir/> and deposited in the ProQuest Dissertations & Theses database.
